



Property Description	Parish Church of St George built on the location of a previous chapel that replaced an even older one in 1456. The dome was built in 1684 by Lorenzo Gafa. The Church architecture follows the Doric style and was restored considerably between 1921 and 1923 when the naves were built. Paintings inside the Church include those of Mattia Preti, Francesco Zahra, Stefano Erardi, Guzeppi Bonnici and Guzeppi Cali.
