She consented to the marriage of Mary Crawford (170) to James Sellers (174) on 19 Dec 1791 at Lincoln Co., Kentucky.<sup>4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11</sup> She consented to the marriage of Sarah Crawford (171) to William David Sellers (5314) on 2 Feb 1796 at Lincoln Co., Kentucky.<sup>12,13,14,15,16,17</sup>

**21** John Crawford<sup>3</sup> Sellers (5333)<sup>41,42,43,44</sup> was born on 26 Mar 1795 at Garrard County, Kentucky.<sup>45,46</sup> He was born between 26 Mar 1795 and 1796 at Garrard County, Kentucky.<sup>47,48,49</sup> He was born on 26 Mar 1796.<sup>50,51</sup> He served during the war of 1812 in the northern frontier and was in the famous charge when the Indian chief Tecumseh was killed at the battle of the Thames.<sup>52</sup> He enlisted as a soldier under R. B. McAfee, Captain in Richard M. Johnson's regiment of Kentucky volunteers mounted infantry, which went to Canada and fought in the battle of the River Thames circa 1813.<sup>53</sup> He ended military service on 19 Nov 1813.<sup>54</sup> He married Fanny Brown (5334) on 1 Mar 1821 at Lancaster, Garrard County, Kentucky.<sup>55,56,57,58,59</sup> He resided in 1823 at Putnam County, Indiana.<sup>60,61</sup> He and IN Putnam County 1830 Census (8463) appeared on the census of 1830 in Putnam County, Indiana, with 2 males under 5, 1 male 10 to 15, 1 male 30 to 40, 3 females under 5, 1 female 10-15, 1 female 20 to 30 and 1 female 50-60 in his household.<sup>62</sup> He was a member of the Presbyterian Church at Putnamville, Putnam County, Indiana.<sup>63</sup> He and IN Putnam County 1840 Census (8462) appeared on the census of 1840 in Washington Township, Putnam County, Indiana, with 1 male under 5, 1 male 10-15, 2 males 15-20, 1 male 40-50, 2 females under 5, 2 females 5-10, 2 females 10-15, 1 female 15-20 and 1 female 30-40 in his household.<sup>64</sup> He is head of household on the census of 22 Aug 1850 at Warren Township, Putnam County, Indiana, as John C. Sellers, a 55 year old male farmer born Kentucky. Enumerated with were Fanny Brown (5334), Mary Sellers (6561), Elizabeth Sellers (6562), Rebecca Sellers (5335), Nancy Sellers (5336), Fannie E. Sellers (6566), John L. Sellers (6565), Martha J. Sellers (6567), Joseph Brown Sellers (6568), and Mary Crawford (170).<sup>65</sup> He died on 1 Nov 1874 at Putnam Co., Indiana.<sup>66,67,68,69</sup> He was buried in Nov 1874 at Putnamville Cemetery, Putnam County, Indiana.<sup>70</sup>

Directly below the W. H. Sellar family is the family of W. Chambers. This is probably the family of Elizabeth Chambers.

I also found an 1870 census record for Wm. H. Sellers Missouri, Phelps County, Roll 797, Book 1, page 689

Further down on the same page is an Eliza Sellers with 3 sons: Wm H. age 7, Geo age 5 and John S. age 3.

There is a fairly active SELLERS research group. The web site is <http://showcase.netins.net/web/sellerfamily/>  
They also have a mailing list that you can subscribe to. If you go to Rootsweb and follow the links for mailing lists you can subscribe to the list (or search the archives).

I'm not actually a Sellers descendant. However, the Sellers family is intertwined with the Crawford family that I am descended from (along with another Crawford line).

So far, I haven't found the family in the 1860 census.
