EDUCATION CITY PROVIDES A CENTRAL NUCLEUS FOR EDUCATION IN GREATER SPRINGFIELD.

Education is a key pillar in Greater Springfield and has been given particular attention through ongoing investment to ensure the full range of quality education services and facilities is available for the city and broader region. Reinforcing this sentiment has been the development of Education City in Springfield Central – a lifelong learning environment, offering tertiary, training and childcare educational services and is the hub for schooling which is provided throughout the community.

Greater Springfield aims to enhance and enrich the entire region through world class education facilities and leading technology – allowing students to reach their aspirations.

Greater Springfield is a fully master planned city founded around the pillars of education, health and technology. With more than 14,000 students from daycare to university already in Greater Springfield, there are many opportunities for life-long learning. The vision for lifelong learning is to deliver at least one job for every three residents of Greater Springfield.

EDUCATION CITY

Education City provides a central nucleus for education in Greater Springfield. Under a hub-and-spoke model, Education City functions as a focal point in the broader educational services offered throughout Greater Springfield and beyond. The campus is already home to numerous education providers such as University of Southern Queensland Springfield Campus, TAFE Queensland South West, Union Institute of Language, Kindy Patch Early Education Centres, student accommodation, tavern and private providers such as The Studio of Performing Arts Springfield. Education City offers a fully integrated educational experience that is geared toward preparing students for a career anywhere around the world.

Education City rightly takes its place within a national and global community through the use of Greater Springfield's dark fibre provision which enables an advanced digital learning network.

GREATER SPRINGFIELD FAST FACTS

- > Project Investment to date - \$12 billion
- > Estimated cost on completion - \$85 billion
- > Total land area - 2,860 hectares (7,067 acres)
- > CBD land area (Springfield Central) – 390 hectares (963 acres) or twice the land area of Brisbane CBD
- > Approval for over 2.6 million square metres of mixed use space in the CBD
- > Access to 86% of Brisbane's metropolitan workforce in a 32 minute drive*
- > Population of over 500,000 within a 22 minute drive of the CBD*
- > Two train stations - Springfield Central and Springfield Lakes now operating
