Levels of exchange (cycles):	In AUEB undergraduate studies are of an official 4-year duration (240 ECTS credits). Incoming students having completed a 3-year 1 st cycle degree programme are accepted at the AUEB 4 th year of studies taking advanced level courses in English. AUEB 2 nd cycle degree programmes are mostly taught in Greek and they accept students holding 1 st cycle degrees with 240 ECTS credits. Deadlines for the nomination of exchange students:	End of June for each year. (For the autumn semester, for the spring semester or for the whole following academic year)
Deadlines for the receipt of applications and other documents of exchange students:	By mid July for each year. (For the autumn semester, for the spring semester or for the whole following academic year (e.g. 15 July 2016 for the academic year 2016-2017))

Minimum requirement for incoming	- They should present a Learning Agreement with 30

students:	ECTS credits per semester in order to be accepted as Erasmus students. - European Card of Health Insurance must be shown upon registration.
Linguistic requirements:	Evidence of English Language Competence equal (or higher) to Level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, as attested by the relevant certificates. Evidence of English Language Competence can also be provided with an official certificate issued by the home institution.
Minimum requirement for outgoing students:	All outgoing students should take a study program of 30 ECTS credits per semester. They must submit with their application an official proof of knowledge of the language taught at the host institution.
