

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Salar Basic Cabled Scarf

This scarf is a quick way to learn cables using big needles and bulky yarn.

Finished Size:

Aprox. 75" long x 6" wide

Materials:

Cascade Yarns® Salar (50% Alpaca / 45% Acrylic / 5% Wool), 197 yds (180 m) /

200 g (7.0 oz)

1 skein of color #11 (Peridot)

US 13 Knitting Needles

Cable Needle Yarn Needle

Gauge:

10 sts x 10 rows = 4" (10 cm)

Abbreviations:

WS = Wrong side
RS = Right side
K = Knit
P = Purl
St(s) = Stitch(es)

Wyib = With yarn in back
Wyif = With yarn in front

SI = Slip stitch from left needle to right needle
C8B = Slip next 4 sts onto cable needle and hold at

back of work, knit next 4 sts from left-hand needle, then knit sts from cable needle

Pattern:

CO 22 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Wyib Sl1 st knitwise, P, K, P, K, P2, K8, P2, K, P, K, P, K

Row 2 (WS): Wyif Sl 1 st purlwise, K, P, K, P, K2, P8, K2, P, K,P, K, P

Row 3: Repeat Row 1



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Row 4: Repeat Row 2

Row 5: Wyib SI 1 st knitwise, P, K, P, K, P2, C8B, P2, K, P, K, P, K

Row 6: Repeat Row 2

Row 7: Repeat Row 1

Row 8: Repeat Row 2

Row 9: Repeat Row 1

Row 10: Repeat Row 2

Repeat Row 1-10 until you are just about out of yarn.

Bind off loosely.
