Perhaps you can create the new posts for the discussions with links included. I'd advise a reverse link to go back to the

original Questions discussion at the top of each discussion.

It becomes a table of contents of sorts.

With each original question, I think it would be wise to state the current dilemmas associated with them. That being, how we must play them either with RAW or RAI or simply that they do not work at all.

I also think that it must be clarified for all contributing and discussing that this is not a new rulebook. Wants and desires for Bretonnia or for rules are not the issue here. This is only in regard to how the new rules work or do not work, either in relation to Bretonnia or for the rules themselves in general.

Also - all involved must realize and accept that Artinam is the collaborating moderator - so to speak. Artinam would have control of the original post which will be the summary. Other moderators will have to contend with all the contributors - perhaps on the behalf of Artinam.
