However, since most communities currently don't vote that way, we strongly urge candidates and voters alike to conduct 'Citizen Audits' of election results. Why? Because Congress has passed laws that allow voting by machine, absentee, and early. Those so-called conveniences make it virtually impossible for poll watchers to oversea the voting process. And that makes our elections dangerously vulnerable to massive miscounts and systemic computer fraud, particularly by unscrupulous election officials and voting machine companies. The purpose of a citizen audit is to verify election results, document complaints, and demonstrate how to run a fair and transparent election. All you need is a cardboard box, some flyers, and audit forms. The paperwork can be easily downloaded from our website. How do you conduct a Citizen Audit? You just stand outside the polls on Election Day and hand out information sheets as voters enter, and then offer them audit forms when they leave. The voter just checks off who they voted for and deposits the form into the audit box. After the polls close, the citizen auditor adds up the results in public. The results are converted into percentages in order to compare 'audit' results to 'official' poll results. We also provide information on how to conduct post-election audits. So please, don't be a sitting duck for election miscounts or manipulation. Audit the election results!
