The following table shows the changes in school tax indexes that were allowed by the state for the Montrose Area School District, as well as the tax increases (values in red) that were approved by the school board since the 2006-2007 school year. The school board has kept community income statistics in mind every year, and has done everything possible to contain operational expenses with minimal tax adjustments.
