PARKING


Permit parking is available at all home football and basketball games. Cowboy Joe Club members at the appropriate donation levels enjoy permit parking in the Ford Stadium Iot, X, IPF, Brown, AA, H, D, Summit View, and VA lots. Please refer to the Cowboy Joe Club parking information, as well as the map below. For football and basketball, single game parking for the general public is available free of charge in the Long-Term Lot (off of 30th), the Aragon Parking Lot (North of Armory Rd.) and in the UW Annex lot (22nd & Garfield). Parking for fans with accessible parking placards is available in parking lots AA, D, S, FA, H and the Cowboy Field Lot. Permit must be shown for admittance to the lots and then properly displayed in the vehicle while parked. There is no charge for Accessible parking, but is on a first-come, first-served basis. There is a shuttle that is available from the ADA Shuttle Lot (Cowboy Field Lot off of Willett Dr.) during games.

*For football, the ADA shuttle will begin 2 hours prior to kick-off and run until 30 minutes after the completion of the game. For basketball, the ADA shuttle will begin 1 hour prior to tip-off and run until 30 minutes after the completion of the game.



SHRVIORS

Accessible Transportation (motorized carts) – For football, the Athletics Department operates motorized carts for transporting disabled patrons from the four concourse entrances up and down the ramps in War Memorial Stadium. For basketball, there will be an ADA golf cart available by the players ramp towards the floor. Should you require shuttle service, please contact the nearest radio-equipped event manager or security personnel and have them contact the cart driver.

ADA Accessible Seating – For football, accessible seating is available on the Upper West side and Upper and Lower East side of the Stadium. For Basketball, accessible seating is available in the following areas: A1, A2, C1, E1, F2 and G1. Fans are encouraged to contact the UW Athletics Ticket Office in advance to purchase tickets in these areas.

Lost and Found – Lost and found items may be turned in at the Athletic Ticket Office in the Arena-Auditorium. All items are then given to the University of Wyoming Police Department. The UW Police lost and found office may be contacted at (307) 766-5788.

Medical – In War Memorial Stadium, one medical station is located on the lower west side, and one on the upper east side. In the Arena-Auditorium, a medical station can be found across from Portal 14 (near the Stadium entrance).

Text Messaging – The University has instituted a system where fans can text a message to gameday personnel. **Please text UWYO to 847411 followed by your issue or question** and a UW staff member will respond.

UW ATHLETICS TICKET OFFICE

The UW Athletics Ticket Office is open Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. and 9:00 am to 1:00 pm on Saturday's. The Ticket Office also opens at 8 a.m. for all home Saturday Football games and 4 hours before tip-off for any weekend men's and women's basketball games.

Tickets may be purchased in advance by calling 877-WYO-FAN1 (877-996-3261) / 307-766-4850 or by visiting the Athletic Department's official website at www. gowyo.com/tickets. There is a no refund, no exchange policy on all purchased tickets.

For football, tickets may be purchased on game days at the following locations:

- East side of War Memorial Stadium (next to Gate 4)
- Stadium entrance of Arena Auditorium (across from Gate 8)
- South end of the Fieldhouse (near Gate 1)

For men's and women's basketball, tickets may be purchased on game days at the following locations:

- Willett West Ticket Booth (A-A)
- Willett East Ticket Booth (A-A)
- Stadium Ticket Booth (A-A)
- · Campus Ticket Booth (A-A).

To pick up will call tickets in advance of gameday, please go to the main ticket office at the Willett West entrance of the Arena Auditorium. For football gamedays, please go to the East side ticket office of War Memorial Stadium next to Gate 4. A picture ID is required to pick up tickets.

Player Guest, Recruits and Coaches – For football, the pass gate for home team guests, recruits and coaches is located at Gate 7 at the northeast corner of the stadium. The pass gate for the visiting team is located at Gate 2 on the south side of the stadium. For both the home and visiting basketball teams, the pass gate is located at the Willett West entrance of the Arena-Auditorium. Admittance is checked by a pass list and a valid photo ID is required.

All full-time and part-time benefited (paid athletics fee) students are allowed admittance to regularly scheduled athletic events held on campus by using their student ID card. The student ID card is not good for post-season events and other special tournaments. Students may enter War Memorial Stadium and the Arena-Auditorium at any entrance. Please note special promotions and student clubs may require entry at a specific entrance.

Arrangements for seats that accommodate wheelchairs can be made in advance by contacting the UW Athletics Ticket Office. Arrangements may also be made in advance for additional guests to accompany the

wheelchair user in those areas if seating is available.

The ticket(s) you have purchased or hold are a revocable license to attend the athletic event. If the ticket holder's conduct endangers or disrupts players, coaches, officials or other patrons, the University reserves the right to remove the ticket holder from the premises. No refunds or exchanges will be made.

TAIL CATING IN PARKING LOTS

All parking lots are open to tailgating activities such as grilling, music and non-alcoholic beverages. However, the Ford Stadium lot, X, IPF, Brown, AA, Summit View and H lots have specific times for open container privileges **for football only**. There are no open container areas for any other UW athletics event.

RULES FOR PARKING LOTS WITH OPEN CONTAINER PERMITS FOR FOOTBALL ONLY

Open containers are permitted beginning at 8am for all games that begin before 4pm and permitted to begin at 12 noon for all games that begin at 4pm or later. Open containers are only allowed until the end of the 3rd Quarter.

No kegs are permitted in the open container lots.

Beer, wine and malt beverages are the only alcoholic beverages permitted in the open container lots on game days.

All tailgating activities must be confined to your particular parking space(s).

Open containers (alcohol) may not be carried on or across public streets.

Violations of the open container permits may result in revocation of parking privileges and removal from the open container area(s). Please observe any/all posted signage.

Open container parking areas are not provided for basketball games.

GAME-DAY POLICIES

Age Requirement – Every person three years of age and older requires a ticket for admission.

Alcoholic Beverages – Consumption and/or possession of alcoholic beverages are not allowed in any Athletic Department facility unless specifically approved by the University.

Animals – Animals are not permitted in Athletic Department facilities. Special admittance may be granted for service animals and team mascots with their official handlers.

Baby Strollers – Folding baby strollers (collapsible umbrella-style) are allowed in War Memorial Stadium and the A-A during athletic events if they can be placed under the patron's seat. Individuals arriving at an event with a stroller that does not adhere to this "fold-up design" will be asked to return it to their car.

Banners, Flyers and Advertisements – All such materials are prohibited at Wyoming Athletic events unless specifically approved by the Wyoming Athletics Department. Non-political/non-commercial signs are permissible at games as long as they are in good taste and do not block the view of fans.

Cameras – Flash photography and video cameras are not permitted at University of Wyoming Athletic events.

Elevator Usage – All persons using the elevator in War Memorial Stadium must present a Wildcatter Suite or Club ticket, a Press Box pass, or an elevator pass for admittance. Other Patrons needing access to the elevator should contact an event staff member for assistance.

Entry – Gates for Jonah Field at War Memorial Stadium open two hours prior to kickoff. Doors to the Arena-Auditorium open one hour prior to tip-off.

Items NOT Permitted – Glass bottles, or any other objects that may be used as a projectile, are not allowed in Athletic Department facilities. No coolers. No outside food or beverages. No flags on poles or sticks. No weapons or other items deemed dangerous or inappropriate. Articles such as blankets, coats, diaper bags, backpacks, fanny packs, and purses are subject to check at all gates/entries.

Noisemakers – In accordance with Mountain West Conference policies, the use of artificial noisemakers (cowbells, horns, thunder sticks, whistles, etc.) are not permissible.

Radios – Radios are permitted, but patrons are encouraged to use headsets or earphones for the consideration of other fans.

Scalping of Tickets – Tickets may not be resold on University property. It does not matter whether the price is a higher value, face value or a discounted price. Scalpers should be reported to uniformed officers.

Security – All security is coordinated and provided by UW Police Department with cooperation from the Albany County Sheriff's Department, Laramie City Police Department and contracted workers. If you require

assistance, please look for a uniformed officer or gameday security.

Smokeless Tobacco – Smokeless tobacco is prohibited.

Smoking – The smoking of cigarettes, cigars, or pipes is prohibited in War Memorial Stadium except in designated areas. Smoking is prohibited throughout the Arena-Auditorium.

Standing – No standing will be permitted on the ramps, portal entries or in the aisles. All customers must occupy an established seat while the game is in progress.

Umbrellas – Open umbrellas are permitted in War Memorial Stadium. Please show courtesy to those around you.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO THE UW CAMPUS

From Cheyenne, Wyoming – Take I-80 West to Laramie (approx. 45 miles). Take the Grand Avenue exit (first exit). Turn right on 22nd Street (fifth stoplight). War Memorial Stadium and the Arena-Auditorium are on your left.

From Fort Collins, Colorado – Take US 287 North to Laramie (approx. 65 miles). Turn right on Grand Avenue (third stoplight). Turn left on 22nd Street (sixth stoplight). War Memorial Stadium and the Arena-Auditorium are on your left.

From Rawlins, Wyoming – Take I-80 East to Laramie (approx. 90 miles). Take the Snowy Range Road exit (second exit). Turn left on Snowy Range Road. Turn right on 3rd Street (first stoplight after overpass). Turn left on Grand Avenue (second stoplight). Turn left on 22nd Street (sixth stoplight). War Memorial Stadium and the Arena-Auditorium are on your left.

From Casper, Wyoming – Take US 220 S (approx. 20 miles). Turn left on US 487 E to Medicine Bow (approx. 70 miles). Turn left on US 30 to Laramie (approx. 50 miles). Turn left on Grand Avenue (fifth stoplight). Turn left on 22nd street (sixth stoplight). War Memorial Stadium and the Arena-Auditorium are on your left.
