

Downpass Standard - Summarized in 6 Points



- The filling material is traced back through specialized audits and the quality is regularly checked. Audits and quality checks are done by neutral third parties.
- The Traceability system is upgraded on a regular basis. The system can examine the Chain of Custody back to the farm.
- We share and check our knowledge with scientists, veterinarians and animal protection organizations and other stakeholders.
- Downpass is adjustable to the customers' needs.
- Downpass labelling serves finished down clothing or down sleeping bags as well as bulk down.

Basics (minimum requirements)

Traceability

Feathers and down must be obtained exclusively from animals previously slaughtered. The down processor is obliged to document the flow of goods according to the EDFA Traceability Standard. EDFA requires that the material has to be traceable back to the slaughterhouse.

Quality

Finished products labelled with Downpass must comply with the quality checks shown on the label. The quality checks are done through Mystery Shopping with subsequent examination of the filling at recognized testing institutes.
