

What you will need:
RED HEART® Detroit: $2(2,2,3)$ balls 08305 Candy OR

RED HEART® Lisa: $4(4,4,6)$ ) balls 08305 Candy

Knitting Needles: 3.75 mm [US 5]
Four $(5,5,6)$ 16-19 mm (5/8-3/4") buttons, yarn needle

TENSION/GAUGE: 23 sts $=10$ $\mathrm{cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime}\right) ; 32$ rows $=10 \mathrm{~cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime}\right)$ in Stockinette stitch. CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the tension/ gauge given. Art. 9809651 available in $100 \mathrm{~g}(3.502), 266$ m (291 yd) balls OR
RED HEART® Lisa, Art. 9809619 available in $50 \mathrm{~g}(1.76 \mathrm{oz}), 133 \mathrm{~m}$ (145 yd) balls


## Sweet as Candy Cardigan

Knit this sweet-as-candy cardigan for the little girl in your life! The lacy eyelet pattern along the edge and cuffs is easier than it looks.

Directions are for size 2; changes for sizes 4, 6 , and 8 are in parentheses.

Finished Chest Measurement: $69(72,80,83)$ cm [271/4 (281/4, 3112, 323/4)"]
Finished Length: $33(35.5,40.5,46.5) \mathrm{cm}[13$ $\left.(14,16,181 / 4)^{\prime \prime}\right]$, with lower edge unrolled

## Special Abbreviations

M1L = Make 1 Left (increase) - insert left needle from front to back under strand between needles, knit strand through the back loop, twisting it to prevent a hole.
M1R = Make 1 Right (increase) - insert left needle from back to front under strand between needles, knit strand through the front loop, twisting it to prevent a hole.

## PATTERN STICHES

$1 \times 1$ Rib (odd number of sts)
Row 1 (Right Side): K2, *p1, k1; repeat from *
to last st, k1.
Row 2: P2, *k1, p1; repeat from * to last st, p1.
Repeat these 2 rows for $1 \times 1$ Rib.
Eyelet Pattern (multiple of 6 sts +3 )
Row 1 (Right Side): K2, *yo, slip 1, k1, psso,
k1, k2tog, yo, k1; repeat from * to last st, k1.
Row 2: Purl.
Row 3: K3, *yo, slip 1, k2tog, psso, yo, k3; repeat from * to last 6 sts, yo, slip 1, k2tog, psso, yo, k3.
Row 4: Purl.
Rep these 4 rows for Eyelet Pattern.

## BACK

Cast on 73 ( $79,85,91$ ) sts.
Work in St st, beginning with a knit row, for 4 $(4,6,6)$ rows.
Work in $1 \times 1$ Rib for $4(4,6,6)$ rows.
first row-75 $(81,87,93)$ sts
Work in Eyelet Pattern until $6(7,8,9)$ vertical repeats have been completed.
Work in St st until piece measures 19 (20.5, $24,28) \mathrm{cm}[7 ½(8,91 / 2,11) "]$ from beginning, ending with a Wrong Side row.

## Shape Raglan Armholes

Next Row (Right Side): Bind off $6(7,6,6)$ sts at beginning of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at beginning and end of next row, every other row $16(16,18,20)$ times, then every 4th row $1(2,2,2)$ time(s), as follows: K1, ssk, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k 1 . Bind off remaining 27 $(29,33,35)$ sts.

## RIGHT FRONT

Cast on $35(37,41,43)$ sts. Work in St st, beginning with a knit row, for 4 $(4,6,6)$ rows.
Work in $1 \times 1$ Rib for $4(4,6,6)$ rows.
Work in St st for 2 rows, inc $4(2,4,2)$ sts evenly on first row-39 $(39,45,45)$ sts. Work in Eyelet Pattern until $6(7,8,9)$ vertical repeats have been completed.
Work in St st until piece measures 19 (20.5, $24,28) \mathrm{cm}[7 ½(8,91 / 2,11) "]$ from beginning, ending with a Right Side row.

## Shape Raglan Armhole and Neck

Next Row (Wrong Side): Bind off $6(7,6,6)$ sts at armhole edge once. Dec 1 st at end of next row, every other row $16(16,18,20)$ times, then every 4th row $1(2,2,2)$ time(s), as follows: Work to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. AT THE SAME TIME, when piece measures 25.5 $(28,32,37) \mathrm{cm}\left[10\left(11,12 \frac{1}{2}, 14 \frac{1}{2}\right)^{\prime \prime}\right]$ from beginning, ending with a Wrong Side Row, shape neck by binding off $7(5,8,6)$ sts at
neck edge once, then decreasing 1 st at neck edge every Right Side row $7(7,9,9)$ times, as follows: K1, ssk, work to end. Fasten off remaining st.

## LEFT FRONT

Cast on $35(37,41,43)$ sts.
Work in St st, beginning with a knit row, for 4 $(4,6,6)$ rows.
Work in $1 \times 1$ Rib for $4(4,6,6)$ rows.
Work in St st for 2 rows, inc $4(2,4,2)$ sts evenly on first row-39 (39, 45, 45) sts. Work in Eyelet Pattern until $6(7,8,9)$ vertical repeats have been completed.
Work in St st until piece measures 19 (20.5, $24,28) \mathrm{cm}\left[7 \frac{112}{2}\left(8,9 \frac{1}{2}, 11\right)^{\prime \prime}\right]$ from beginning, ending with a Wrong Side row.

## Shape Raglan Armhole and Neck

Next Row (Right Side): Bind off $6(7,6,6)$ sts at armhole edge once. Dec 1 st at beginning of next Right Side row, every other row 16 $(16,18,20)$ times, then every 4th row $1(2$, 2,2 ) time(s), as follows: K1, ssk, work to end. AT THE SAME TIME, when piece measures $25.5(28,32,37) \mathrm{cm}\left[10\left(11,12 \frac{1}{2}, 141 / 2\right)^{\prime \prime}\right]$ from beginning, ending with a Right Side Row, shape neck by binding off $7(5,8,6)$ sts at neck edge once, then decreasing 1 st at neck edge every Right Side row $7(7,9,9)$ times, as follows: Work to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. Fasten off remaining st.

## SLEEVES

Cast on $35(37,41,43)$ sts.
Work in St st, beginning with a knit row, for 4 $(4,6,6)$ rows.
Work in $1 \times 1$ Rib for $4(4,6,6)$ rows.
Work in St st for 2 rows, inc $4(2,4,2)$ sts evenly on first row- $39(39,45,45)$ sts.

## Shape Sleeve

Next Row (Right Side): Work in Eyelet Pattern until $6(7,8,9)$ vertical repeats have been completed, then change to St st across all sts. AT THE SAME TIME, shape sleeve by increasing 1 st at each edge on first row of Eyelet Pattern, every 8th (6th, 8th, 6th) row 4 $(4,6,6)$ times, then every 8 th row $0(2,0,2)$ times, working increased sts in St st as they become available, as follows: K1, M1R, work to last st, M1L, k1—49 (53, 59, 63) sts. Work even until piece measures $18(20.5,23,24)$ $\mathrm{cm}\left[7(8,9,91 / 2)^{\prime \prime}\right]$ from beginning, ending with a Wrong Side Row.

## Shape Raglan Cap

Next Row (Right Side): Bind off $6(7,6,6)$ sts at beginning of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st each side every other row $13(13,17,17)$ times, then every 4th row $3(4,3,4)$ times, as follows: K 1 , ssk, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1. Bind off remaining $5(5,7,9)$ sts.

## FINISHING

Sew raglan seams. Sew side and Sleeve seams.

## Button Band

With Right Side facing, beginning at base of Left Front neck, pick up and knit 63 (71, 81, 93) sts along Left Front edge, ending at bottom of $1 \times 1$ Rib, above St st rows. Work in $1 \times 1$ Rib, beginning with a Wrong Side row, for $6(6,6,8)$ rows. Bind off all sts in Rib.

## Buttonhole Band

Place markers for $4(5,5,6)$ buttonholes evenly spaced just inside Right Front edge, with first buttonhole $1.5 \mathrm{~cm}\left(1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ above bottom of $1 \times 1$ Rib, last buttonhole 1.5 cm $(1 / 2$ ") below neck edge, and remaining $2(3,3$, 4) buttonholes evenly spaced between. With Right Side facing, beginning at bottom of 1 x h first buttonhole $1.5 \mathrm{~cm}(1 / 2)$ above

1 Rib, above St st rows, pick up and knit 63 $(71,81,93)$ sts along Right Front edge, ending at base of Right Front neck. Work in $1 \times 1$ Rib, beginning with a Wrong Side row, for 6 ( 6,6 , 8) rows, working buttonholes at markers on Row 3, as follows: Buttonhole Row (Wrong Side): [Work to marker, yo, work 2 sts together (k2tog if next st is a purl st, or p2tog if next st is a knit st)] $4(5,5,6)$ times, work to end. Bind off all sts in Rib.

## Neck Band

With RS facing, beginning in center of Buttonhole Band, pick up and knit 77 ( 75,93 , 91) sts evenly around neck. Work in $1 \times 1$ Rib, beginning with a Wrong Side row, for 6 ( 6,8 , 8) rows, decreasing $8(8,12,12)$ sts in Rib on first row-69 (67, 81, 79) sts. Work in St st for $4(4,6,6)$ rows. Bind off all sts purlwise.

Sew buttons opposite buttonholes.
Weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

$\mathrm{cm}=$ centimeters; dec = decrease; inc = increase; $\mathbf{k}=$ knit; $k 2$ tog $=$ knit next two sts together; $\mathbf{m m}=$ millimeters; $\mathrm{p}=$ purl; p2tog $=$ purl next two sts together; $\mathbf{s t}(\mathbf{s})=\operatorname{stitch}($ (es $) ;$ St st = Stockinette stitch; yo = yarnover; [ ] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * or ** $=$ repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.
