DO NOT ride on hills facing the road
DO NOT ride outside practice or event times
Breaches will incur penalty points and/or event exclusion

#### Current Fire Danger Period Requirements

Barbecues and campfires for warmth or comfort are permitted as per CFA instructions only if:

- The wind is not more than 10kph
- The fire is lit in a properly constructed fireplace or trench at least 30cm deep
- The fire is not within 7.5 metres of a log or stump
- The ground and air space within 3 metres are clear of flammable material
- The fire and fuel used are the minimum necessary for the purpose and do not occupy an area of more than 1 sq metre
- A person is in attendance at all times while the fire is alight.

Note that in accordance with the CFA Act, a "properly constructed fireplace" means a fireplace that is constructed of stone (rocks), metal, concrete or any other non-flammable material so as to contain the perimeter of the fire.

A commercially produced barbecue would be considered a properly constructed fireplace. Use of a fire bucket is recommended and all fires must be totally extinguished before leaving.

Persons intending to engage in recreational activities may purchase a 1 event recreation licence on site (cost \$30) but MUST pass scrutineering requirements and MUST produce proof of current ambulance cover - no exceptions.

"All machines (competitors and officials) must be fitted with an effective ignition cut-out switch as per the "2016 Manual of Motorcycle Sport"

(Failure to comply will attract an additional 5 point penalty which can be applied by either the Observer, Clerk of Course or Steward.)

#### **GENERAL**

- 1. **Noise:** All machines must comply with the 2016 GCR's (Moms 20.12). Machines must be no greater than 112db +/-4db and can be inspected by the Stewards at any time of the meeting. Refer to the Moms 20.12. The Clerk of Course or the Stewart will give the final approval to ride the event for any machine that is above the measured result.
- 2. **Numbers & Numberplates:** Must comply with these Supplementary Regulations
- 3. **Change of Motorcycle:** A change of motorcycle may be permitted during the event provided that the notice is in writing and handed to the secretary of the meeting and approval obtained by the stewards The same type of machine must be used (modern, classic, sidecar etc).
- 4. **Points Score:** As per 2016 Manual of Motorcycle Sport.
- 5. **Riding of Motorcycles:** The riding of any competing motorcycles in the pits or car park or camping area is not permitted. Infringing riders will be brought before the stewards of the meeting. Any offender may be fined \$50.00, which must be paid before any further participation is permitted. No pit bikes or non competing motorcycles are permitted to be ridden at any time at the venue.
- 6. **No Hassle Policy:** Any rider, entrant or person associated with a rider or entrant shall conduct themselves in an orderly manner in any dealings whatsoever, with any official of the meeting. A rider shall be responsible for his/her own conduct and that of any person with whom he/she is associated who abuses or threatens in any manner, either verbally or physically, any official. Penalties, which may be imposed by the stewards for breach, include reprimand or warning. Minimum \$50.00 fine or exclusion from the meeting.
- 7. Abandonment: In the event of the meeting being abandoned due to circumstances beyond the control of the promoters before racing commences, entry fees will be returned, less a fee per entry to cover administration costs. Once the competition has commenced only the stewards of the meeting have the authority to abandon the meeting and their decision shall be final. In such cases the stewards will rule on the results according to the circumstances.
- 8. **Bicycles:** Bicycles are not permitted in the pits or on the racing circuit. No Pit Bikes will be allowed anywhere at this complex.
- Animals: Dogs must be on a leash at all times. No other animals will be permitted entry to the grounds.
- 11. **Motorcycles:** Are to be kept in the pit area at all times when not being used for competition. Unless permission to remove the motorcycle has been granted by the stewards of the meeting. Any motorcycle removed from the pit area without permission of the stewards, will be deemed to have withdrawn from the competition.
- 12. **Reservations:** The Stewards of the meeting reserve the right to alter, postpone or cancel all or part of the events program.
- 13. **Unauthorised:** Persons are prohibited from entering the track infield area. Such unauthorised persons will be removed from prohibited areas.
- 14. IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL RIDERS/ENTRANTS/PARENTS/GUARDIANS: CAPITAL BENEFITS INSURANCE IS APPLICABLE TO ALL RIDERS WITH A CURRENT LICENCE.
  - It is conditional upon acceptance of this entry that it is fully understood by the rider/entrant/parent/guardian to arrange personal injury and ambulance transportation insurance cover in case you should require the same during the running of this competition.

RIDERS INSURANCE: The Motorcycling Australia Insurance Scheme provides: As per 2016 Manual of Motorcycle Sport.

#### **ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS, DANGERS & OBLIGATIONS**

- I ACKNOWLEDGE that:
- motorcycle sport is dangerous and that by engaging in the sport (whether as a competitor, recreational rider, coach, official or media) at the Meeting I take and am exposed to certain risks and am under certain obligations as follows: a)

- the Indemnitees do not make any warranty that the services at the Meeting will be provided with due care and skill or that any materials provided in connection with the services will be fit for the purpose for which they are supplied;
- to the extent that any warranty is implied it is excluded to the full extent permitted by law; have voluntarily read and understood this warning and accept and assume the inherent risks in participating in the Event. c) d)

#### WARNING UNDER THE FAIR TRADING ACT 1999 (VIC)

I understand it is compulsory for me to have ambulance insurance in some form and I accept responsibility for the cost of ambulance

#### **PRIVACY**
