

The **Hudson/Park Neighborhood Association (H/PNA)** is a not-for-profit organization committed to a positive sense of community and a high quality of life for owners, tenants and businesses.

The area includes some of the best of Albany's historic buildings and boarders Washington Park, rated as one of the finest historic urban parks in the United States. And, in close proximity to the neighborhood, is the city's main library, state library, major museums, the State Capitol, and numerous state and local government agencies.

The neighborhood's own business district – Lark Street – provides residents and visitors with an abundance of restaurant choices as well as jewelry and other speciality shops.

The neighborhood demographic composition is diverse, providing a vibrant, urban living experience for all residents.



The purpose of H/PNA is to:

- ✓ foster a spirit of community and cooperation among residents of the neighborhood.
- encourage neighborhood diversity as regards income, ethnicity, religion, political outlook, sexual orientation, etc.
- ✓ promote responsible relationships between landlords and tenants.
- encourage the restoration, rehabilitation, and appropriate maintenance and use of all property in the neighborhood.
- work with public and private agencies to facilitate appropriate zoning and land use policies.



Membership in H/PNA is open to all residents – homeowners, renters and business owners.

As a member you can: attend and vote at general meetings; participate in neighborhood-wide events (like Spring Cleanup) that benefit you and your community; volunteer for ad hoc activities (like making a dish for the Winter Brunch); volunteer for on-going activities (like becoming a Block Captain on your street); and run for association office.
