What you will need:

RED HEART® Comfort: 4 balls
3132 Off White

Crochet Hook: 5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle

TENSION/GAUGE: Square = 17
cm [7½"]. CHECK YOUR TENSION/
GAUGE. Use any size hook to
obtain the tension/gauge.

Crochet Cable Squares

This beautifully designed classic is perfect in any room or to give as a special anniversary or wedding gift. Crocheted in one colour squares (any colour you wish), it is perfect to take along to keep your fingers busy wherever you go.

Throw measures 119 x 157 cm [47" x 62"].

Special Abbreviations

corner = (2 tr, ch 3, 2 tr) all in next ch-3 space.

fpdtr (front post double treble) = [yo] twice, insert hook from front to back to front around post of st indicated, yo and draw yarn through, [yo and draw through 2 loops] 3 times. Skip st behind fpdtr.

cable (uses next 4 sts) = skip next 2 sts, fpdtr around next 2 sts; working in front of fpdtr just made, fpdtr around first skipped st, then around next skipped st. Skip 4 sts behind cable.

fptr (front post treble) = yo, insert hook from front to back to front around post of st indicated, yo and draw yarn through, [yo and draw through 2 loops] twice. Skip st behind fptr.

Dec (decrease) = [draw up a loop in next st] twice, yo and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

THROW

Square (Make 48)

Round 1 (Right Side): Ch 4; tr in 4th ch from hook, ch 3, [2 tr, ch 3] 3 times all in same ch; join with a slip st to top of beginning ch.

Round 2: Ch 3, tr in next tr, corner, * tr in next 2 tr, corner; repeat from * around; join to top of ch-3.

Round 3: Slip st in next 3 tr, ch 3, corner, tr in next tr, cable, * tr in next tr, corner, tr in next tr, cable; repeat from * around; join.

Round 4: Ch 4, * skip next tr, tr in next tr, corner, tr in next tr, ch 1, skip next tr, tr in next tr, fptr around next 4 fpdtr **, tr in next tr, ch 1; repeat from * around, end at **; join to 3rd ch of ch-4.

Round 5: Ch 4, * skip next st, tr in next tr, ch 1, skip next tr, tr in next tr, corner, tr in next tr, [ch 1, skip next st, tr in next tr] twice, cable **, tr in next tr, ch 1; repeat from * around, end at **; join to 3rd ch of ch-4.

Round 6: Ch 4, * tr in next tr, [ch 1, skip next st, tr in next tr] twice, corner, tr in next tr, [ch 1, skip next st, tr in next tr] 3 times, fptr around next 4 fpdtr **, tr in next tr, ch 1; repeat from * around, end at **; join to 3rd ch of ch-4.

Round 7: Ch 4, * tr in next tr, [ch 1, skip next st, tr in next tr] 3 times, corner, tr in next tr, [ch 1, skip next st, tr in next tr] 4 times, cable **, tr in next tr, ch 1; repeat from * around, end at **; join to 3rd ch of ch-4. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew 8 squares together into 6 vertical strips, then sew strips together.

BORDER

Round 1: With right side facing, join yarn in any corner ch-3 space; ** ch 1, (dc, ch 2, dc) all in corner space, * ch 1, dc in next tr, ch 1, skip next st, [dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] 5 times, dec, [ch 1, skip next st, dc in next st] 6 times, ch 1, skip next ch, dc in next ch, ch 1, skip seam, dc in next ch, ch 1, skip next ch, [dc in next st, ch 1, skip next st] 6 times, dec, [ch 1, skip next st, dc in next st] 6 times; repeat from * to next corner; repeat from ** around; ch 1; join with a slip st to first dc.

Round 2: Ch 1, dc in first dc, ** (dc, ch 2, dc) all in ch-2 space, dc in next dc, * ch 1, dc in next dc; repeat from * to next corner; repeat from ** around; ch 1; join.

Round 3: Ch 1, dc in first dc, ch 1, skip next dc, ** (dc, ch 2, dc) all in ch-2 space, ch 1, skip next dc, * dc in next dc, ch 1, skip next st; repeat from * to next corner; repeat from ** around; join.

Round 4: Ch 1, slip st in next space, ch 1, ** (slip st, ch 2, slip st) all in ch-2 space, ch 1, * slip st in next space, ch 1; repeat from * to next corner; repeat from ** around; join.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

ch = chain; **cm** = centimeters; **dc** = double crochet; **dtr** = double treble crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tr** = triple or treble crochet; **yo** = yarn over; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; *** or **** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.



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
