



What you will need:

RED HEART® Amore: 3 balls 00002 Ecru

Knitting Needles: 6.5mm [US 10½] Round purse handles, cable needle, yarn needle

TENSION/GAUGE: 14 sts = 10 cm [4"]; 20 rows = 10 cm [4"] in Stockinette stitch. CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the tension/gauge.

Knit Cabled Bag

Knit yourself a classic purse for carrying your knitting project or to take along each day. It has a horseshoe cable in the center and seed stitch on each side for a timeless look.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

4/4 LC: Slip 4 sts to cable needle and hold in front, k4, then k4 from cable needle. **4/4 RC:** Slip 4 sts to cable needle and hold in back, k4, then k4 from cable needle.

KNIT CABLED BAG (Make 2)

Cast on 64 sts

Row 1, 3, 7, and 9 (Right Side): P2, [k1, p1]) 9 times, p4, k16, p4, [k1, p1] 9 times, p2. Row 2 and All Wrong Side Rows: K2, [p1, k1] 9 times, k4, p16, k4, [p1, k1] 9 times, k2. Row 5: P2, [k1, p1] 9 times, p4, 4/4 RC, 4/4 LC, p4, [k1, p1] 9 times, p2. Repeat Rows 1-10 for seven more times, then

Repeat Rows 1-10 for seven more times, then Rows 1-2 once. Cast off.

FINISHING

Aligning Cables at lower edge of Bag, sew pieces together at lower edge and sides. Leaving 5 cm [2"] from each side edge along top edge unsewn and gathering remaining top edge, sew top edges to purse handles. Weave in ends.

Abbreviations: cm = centimeters; k = knit; mm = millimeters; p = purl; st(s) = stitch(es); [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
