What you will need:

RED HEART® Baby: 1 ball each 08507 Sky Blue **A**, 08528 Cream **B**, and 08531 Pale Coral **C**

Crochet Hook: 3.25mm [US D-3]

Black embroidery floss, yarn needle

TENSION/GAUGE: 16 sts = 8 cm [3"]; 12 rounds = 8 cm [3"] alternating 1 row in dc and 1 row in tr. CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the tension/gauge.

Puppy Booties

Crochet these adorable puppy booties for the baby in your life! Any of the colours of our soft Baby yarn can be used as the main shade.

Fits 3-6 month old Baby

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

dc2tog: [Draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

BOOTIE

With **A**. ch 10.

Round 1: Dc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 7 ch, 3 dc in last ch, turn to work along opposite side of foundation ch, dc in next 7 ch, 2 dc in last ch – 20 dc.

Round 2: 2 dc in first dc, dc in next 7 dc, 2 dc in next 3 dc, dc in next 7 dc, 2 dc in last 2 dc – 26 dc.

Round 3: Dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next 6 dc, htr in next 2 dc, 2 tr in next 5 dc, htr in next 2 dc, dc in next 6 dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in last dc – 34 sts.

Round 4: Dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next 10 sts, [2 dc in next st, dc in next 2 sts] 3 times, dc in next 8 sts, 2 dc in next st, dc in next 2 sts, 2 dc in last st – 40 dc.

Round 5: Dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in next st, dc in next 6 sts, htr in next st, [tr in next 2 sts, 2 tr in next st] 5 times, tr in next 2 sts, htr in next st, dc in next 6 sts, 2 dc in next st, dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in last st – 48 sts.

Round 6: [Dc in next 7 sts, 2 dc in next st] around – 54 sts.

Round 7: Working in back loops only, dc in each st around.

Round 8: Slip st in first dc, ch 3, (counts as first tr here and throughout), tr in each dc around, slip st in top of beginning ch-3 to join.

Round 9: Ch 1, dc in same st as join, dc in next 7 sts, [dc in next st, dc2tog] 12 times, dc in 10 sts, slip st in first dc – 42 dc.

Round 10: Ch 3, tr in each st around, slip st in beginning ch-3.

Round 11: Ch 1, dc in same st as join, dc in next 9 sts, [dc in next st, dc2tog] 6 times, dc in 14 sts, slip st in first dc – 36 dc.

Round 12: Repeat Round 10.

Round 13: Ch 1, dc in same st as join and in next 7 sts, [dc in next st, dc2tog] 6 times, dc in 10 sts, slip st in first dc – 30 dc.

Round 14: Repeat Round 10.

Round 15: Ch 1, dc in same st as join, dc in st around, slip st in first dc.

Rounds 16-19: Repeat Rounds 14-15. Fasten off.

Cheek (Make 2)

With B. ch 2.

Round 1: 6 dc in 2nd ch from hook.

Round 2: 2 dc in each dc around – 12 dc.

Round 3: [Dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc]

around - 18 dc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Tongue

With **C**. ch 2.

Work 5 dc in 2nd ch from hook. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Eye (Make 2)

With B. ch 3.

Dc in 2nd ch from hook, 3 dc in last dc, turn to work along opposite side of foundation ch, 2 dc in next dc, slip st in first dc to join. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. With black embroidery floss, embroider pupils in centre of each eye in satin st.

Ear (Make 2)

With **B**, ch 6.

Round 1: Dc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 2 ch, htr in next ch, 5 tr in last ch, turn to work along opposite side of ch, htr in next ch, dc in next 3 ch – 13 sts.

Round 2: Ch 1, turn, dc in next 3 sts, htr in next 2 sts, 2 tr in next 3 sts, htr in next 2 sts, dc in next 3 sts – 16 sts.

Round 3: Ch 1, turn, dc in next 5 sts, htr in next st, 2 tr in next 4 sts, htr next st, dc in next 5 sts – 20 sts.

Round 4: Do in next 7 sts, htr next st, 2 tr in next 4 sts, htr next st, do in 7 sts. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Fold flat end in half and sew together. Sew one Ear on either side of Bootie.

FINISHING

Following photo, sew Eyes, Cheeks and Tongue on Bootie. Embroider nose between cheeks in satin stitch using embroidery floss. Weave in ends.

Abbreviations

A, B, C = Colour A, B, C; **ch** = chain; **cm** = centimetres; **dc** = double crochet; **htr** = half treble crochet; **mm** = millimetres; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tog** = together; **tr** = triple or treble crochet; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
