




COMPANY:	The survey was conducted by the company DATA RC on behalf of pelop.gr.
OBJECTIVE:	Exploring the attitudes and views of the electorate and voting intention.
SAMPLE CHARACTERISTICS – SAMPLING METHOD:	Representative sample of men and women 18 years and older based on 2001 census. Multistage stratified sampling using quota of sex, age, region voting.
WEIGHTING FACTORS:	The results have been weighted by the May 6 th 2012 vote
TIME – VENUE:	28-30/5/2012 NATIONWIDE
TYPE:	Quantitative research by telephone interviews using a structured questionnaire, at the respondents' households.
OTHER:	The survey was conducted in accordance with the rules of conduct for political and social research set by the ICC / ESOMAR.
SAMPLE:	Men 46,6% Women 53,4%. The sample size is 1,007 men and women aged 18 and older.


«What will you vote at next election?»

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




«How confident are you for your vote;»
