

Size: to fit 1934"-2114" [50-54 cm] head circumference

If you'd like to make this hat, you will need the following materials:

2, 50 g (68 yd/63 m) balls **Schachenmayr Catania Grande** color #03249 Gold (MC)

1, 50 g (68 yd/63 m) ball **Schachenmayr Catania Grande** color #03205 Apple (CC)

5, Size 6 US (4 mm) double-pointed needles

5, Size 9 US (5.5 mm) double-pointed needles Yarn needle, 2 ring stitch markers, 1 locking stitch marker

My Mountain logo label

Gauge: 15 sts x 28 rnds = 4" x 4" [10 x 10 cm] in Garter st with larger ndls

Take time to check your gauge.

These are the knit stitches you will need to make this hat:

Stockinette st (in rnds): K every rnd for St st in the rnd.

Stockinette st (in rows): *Knit | row, purl | row; rep from * across for St st in rows.

Garter st (in rnds): *Knit | rnd, purl | rnd; rep from * for Garter st in the rnd.

Rib pattern: *K2, p2; rep from * across/around for Rib patt.

Let's get started! Here are the instructions:

Hat is worked from the top down.

With larger dpns and MC, CO 4 sts. Arrange sts evenly on 4 ndls [1 st per ndl]. Join to work in rnds, being careful not to twist the sts. PM to indicate beg of rnd. Beg Garter st in rnds.

Shape Crown

Rnd 1: KIf&b around [8 sts]. Rnd 2: KIf&b around [16 sts].



Rnd 3 and all foll odd-numbered rnds: Purl.

 $\underline{\text{Rnd 4:}}$ *K1, klf&b; rep from * 7 more times [24 sts].

Rnd 6: *K2, klf&b; rep from *7 more times [32 sts].

 $\underline{\text{Rnd 8:}}$ *K3, klf&b; rep from * 7 more times [40 sts].

 $\underline{\text{Rnd 10:}}$ *K4, klf&b; rep from * 7 more times [48 sts].

Rnd 12: *K5, klf&b; rep from * 7 more times [56 sts].

Rnd 14: *K6, klf&b; rep from * 7 more times 164 sts 1.

Rnd 16: *K7, klf&b; rep from *7 more times [72 sts].

Rnd 18: *K8, klf&b; rep from * 7 more times [80 sts].



Cont in Garter st in rnds over 80 sts until hat meas 63/4" [17 cm] from CO. Change to smaller dpns.

Next rnd: With MC, knit around.

Next rnd: With CC, knit 4 rnds.

Next rnd: With CC, beg Rib patt.

Next rnd: Loosely bind off all sts.

Brim

Place locking stitch marker at center front of hat. With RS facing, smaller dpns, and CC, pick up and k8 sts before marker. Pick up and k9 sts after marker [17 sts total]. Remove locking stitch marker. Row 1 (WS): P2, place ring stitch marker, p13, place ring stitch marker, p2.

Row 2 (RS): Pick up and kI from the edge of hat; knit to marker, MIR, slm, knit to next marker, MIR, slm, knit to row end; pick up and kI from the edge of hat [2] sts].

Row 3 (WS): Purl across, slipping markers as they appear.

Repeat last two rows 7 more times [49 sts].

Row 18 (RS): Discard markers as they appear. Pick up and k1 from edge of hat; work in Rib patt to row end; pick up and k1 from edge of hat [51 sts].

Row 19 (WS): Purl across.

Next row (RS): Loosely bind off all sts kwise. Weave in all ends on wrong side of work. Sew on My Mountain label.

You've done it - your My Mountain hat is finished!

Abbreviations

beg begin(ning)

dpn(s) double-pointed needle(s)

CO cast on foll following

klf&b knit into front and back of same st (1 st

inc'd)

kwise knitwise

MIR make 1 st right slant; insert left ndl from back to front under the ladder

between sts on left and right ndls. Knit this lifted strand through the front.

meas measures
ndl(s) needle(s)

patt pattern

PM place marker rem remain(ing)

rep repeat rnd(s) round(s)

RS right side

skp SI 1 st as if to knit, k1, pass slipped st

over knitted st

slm slip marker

St st Stockinette stitch

st(s) stitch(es)
