The Richmondshire (Parishes) Order 2002

Made - - - - 1st April 2002

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 14 and 23 of the Local Government and Rating Act 1997(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order which gives effect (without modification) to recommendations made to him by the Richmondshire District Council following a review conducted by them in accordance with Part II of that Act, for the alteration of the area of parishes and the amalgamation of two parishes within the district of Richmondshire:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Richmondshire (Parishes) Order 2002.
- (2) It shall come into force-
 - (a) for the purposes of this article, and proceedings preliminary or relating to elections to be held on 1st May 2003, on 15th October 2002;
 - (b) for all other purposes, on 1st April 2003.
- (3) In this Order –

“the new parish” means the parish constituted by article 3;

“existing” means existing on the date on which this Order is made; and

“the map” means the map prepared by the Department for Transport, Local Government and the Regions, marked "Map of the Richmondshire (Parishes) Order 2002" and deposited in accordance with regulation 6(1) of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Council) Regulations 1999(b); and

any reference to a numbered sheet is a reference to the sheet of the map which bears that number.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order gives effect to the recommendations of a review sent to the Secretary of State by Richmondshire District Council, for the establishment of a new parish and the alteration of areas of other parishes within the District. A map forming part of this note gives a general guide to the areas concerned.

Articles 2 to 5 make provision for the establishment of a new parish of East Witton from the amalgamation of the existing parishes of East Witton Out and East Witton Town and the abolition of the existing parishes. The first elections to the new parish council shall take place on 1st May 2003.

Article 6 makes alterations to the areas of parishes. On 1st April 2003 each area specified in column (1) of the Schedule to the Order will cease to be part of the parish specified in column (2) and will become part of the parish specified in column (3).

Prints of the map referred to in the Order may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the offices of the Richmondshire District Council and at the offices of the Secretary of State for Transport, Local Government and the Regions, Ashdown House, 123 Victoria Street, London SW1E 6DE.

Parishes of East Witton Out and East Witton Town

2. The parishes of East Witton Out and East Witton Town shall be abolished.

Constitution of a new parish

3.—(1) A new parish, comprising the area delineated by a blue line on sheet 1 shall be constituted within the district of Richmondshire.

(2) The name of the new parish shall be East Witton.

Directions to establish parish council

4.—(1) The Richmondshire District Council is hereby directed to establish a parish council for the new parish.

(2) 1st April 2003 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parish and Parish Council) Regulations 1999.

Transitional Provision

5. Until the councillors elected to the council of the new parish at the elections to be held on 1st May 2003 come into office, the parish shall be represented by those persons who are the elected councillors holding office immediately before 1st April 2003 for the existing parishes of East Witton Out and East Witton Town.

Alterations of parish areas

6. Each area shaded in blue, designated by a letter on sheet 2 and specified in column (1) of the Schedule shall cease to be part of the parish specified in relation to that area in column (2) and shall become part of the parish specified in column (3).
