



What you will need:

RED HEART® Baby: 2 balls 08529 Taupe A; 1 ball 08528 Cream B

Knitting Needles: 2.75 mm [US 2] and 3mm [US 3]

Stitch markers, pins, yarn needle

TENSION/GAUGE: 20 sts = 10 cm [4]; 32 rows = 10 cm [4]in 1 x 1 Rib with smaller needle, unstretched. 25 sts = 10 cm [4]; 35 rows = 10 cm [4] in St stwith larger needle. CHECK YOUR TENSION/GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the tension/ gauge.

Cosy Lamb Hat

Knit this fun bobbled hat with ears and your little lamb will look picture-perfect!

Hat circumference at bottom edge:

Hat will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

42 cm [16½"]

MB = Make Bobble - K1, p1, k1 into nextstitch, turn work; k3, turn work; p3, turn work; k3, turn work; slip 1, k2tog, psso.

k1fb = knit into the front and back of next stitch.

PATTERN STITCHES

1 x 1 Rib (multiple of 2 sts)

All rows: *K1, p1; repeat from * to end. Repeat this row across an even number of sts for 1 x 1 Rib.

Notes

- 1. Hat is worked flat from top down and seamed with yarn tail.
- 2. Ears are worked flat from bottom of ear to tip and seamed with varn tail. When changing colours for center of ears, strand yarn not in use across the wrong side of the work.
- 3. Use photo as guide for attaching ears.

HAT

Shape Crown

With A and using larger needles, cast on 27 sts.

Row 1 (Wrong Side): Knit.

Row 2: K1, [MB in next st, k1] 13 times.

Row 3: [K2, k1fb] 9 times - 36 sts.

Row 4: [K1, MB in next st] 18 times.

Row 5: [K3, k1fb] 9 times – 45 sts.

Row 6: K1, [MB in next st, k1] 22 times.

Row 7: [K4, k1fb] 9 times – 54 sts.

Row 8: [K1. MB in next st] 27 times.

Row 9: [K5, k1fb] 9 times – 63 sts.

Row 10: K1, [MB in next st, k1] 31 times.

Row 11: [K6, k1fb] 9 times – 72 sts.

Row 12: [K1, MB in next st] 36 times.

Row 13: [K7, k1fb] 9 times – 81 sts.

Row 14: K1, [MB in next st, k1] 40 times.

Row 15: [K8, k1fb] 9 times – 90 sts.

Row 16: [K1. MB in next st] 45 times.

Row 17: Knit.

Row 18: [K1. MB in next st] 45 times.

Row 19: [K24, k1fb, k19, k1fb] twice – 94 sts.

Row 20: [K1, MB in next st] 47 times.

Row 21: Knit.

Crown of hat is complete.

Body

Row 22: [MB in next st, k1] 47 times.

Row 23: Knit.

Row 24: [K1, MB in next st] 47 times.

Row 25: Knit.

Repeat last 4 rows 2 more times, or until hat measures 15 cm [6] from cast on.

Change to smaller needles.

Next Row: Knit.

Ribbing

Work 7 rows in 1 x 1 Rib. Cast off loosely in pattern, leaving a 30.5 cm [12] tail for seaming.

EARS (Make 2)

With A, larger needles and leaving long tail for seaming ear to hat, cast on 35 sts. Beginning with a purl row and slipping the first st of every row as if to knit, work 3 rows St st.

Row 4 (Right Side): With A, slip 1, k11; join B, k11: with **A**. k12.

Continue in St st and colors as established, slipping first st, for 11 more rows.

Row 16 (Right Side): With A, slip 1, k12; with **B**. k9: with **A**. k13.

Row 17: With **A**. slip 1. p12: with **B**. p9: with **A**, p13.

Please Note: Print this pattern using Landscape Orientation.

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Row 18 (Decrease Row): With A, slip 1, k1, [k2tog] twice, k8; with B, k7; with A, k8, [k2tog] twice, k2 – 31 sts.

Row 19: With **A**, slip 1, p11; with **B**, p7; with **A**, p12.

Row 20 (Decrease Row): With A, slip 1, k1, [k2tog] twice, k6; with B, k7; with A, k6, [k2tog] twice, k2 – 27 sts.

Row 21: With **A**, slip 1, p9; with **B**, p7; with **A**, p10.

Row 22 (Decrease Row): With A, slip 1, k1, [k2tog] twice, k6; with B, k3; with A, k6, [k2tog] twice, k2 – 23 sts. Cut B; continue with A.

Row 23: Purl.

Row 24 (Decrease Row): Slip 1, k1, [k2tog] twice, k11, [k2tog] twice, k2 – 19 sts.

Row 25: Purl.

Row 26 (Decrease Row): Slip 1, k1, [k2tog] twice, k7, [k2tog] twice, k2 – 15 sts.

Row 27: Purl.

Row 28 (Decrease Row): Slip 1, k1, [k2tog] twice, k3, [k2tog] twice, k2 – 11 sts.

Row 29: P1, [p2tog] twice, p1, [p2tog] twice, p1 – 7 sts.

Cast off, leaving 30.5 cm [12] tail. Thread tail on tapestry needle; with wrong sides together and using whipstitch, sew side edges of ear together. Turn ear right side out, and continue seaming along bottom of ear.

Fold ear lengthwise, bringing outer edges together at bottom; sew sides together. Set aside.

FINISHING

With wrong sides together, long tail and using whipstitch, seam sides of hat together. Fasten off.

Using photo as guide, pin ears to opposite sides of hat, approximately 12.5 cm [5"] from center of crown. Using tails, sew ears to hat; fasten off. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Colours A, B, C; k = knit; p = purl; st(s) = stitch(es); St st = Stockinette stitch; psso = pass slipped stitch over; k2tog = knit next 2 sts together; p2tog = purl next 2 sts together; cm = centimetres; mm = millimetres; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.





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
