LOCAL AREA

Thorney is an island which juts into Chichester Harbour in West Sussex. It is separated from the mainland by a narrow channel called the Great Deep. The old village of West Thorney lies on the East coast of the Island and is incorporated into the military base.

A public footpath, part of the Sussex border path, encircles the Island. The Southern part of the Island is accessed by security controlled sluice gates and public access to this area is limited to the coastal path and the church of St Nicholas at West Thorney. The harbour is a bird sanctuary and has various sites of special scientific interest. The Island has a large area of sandy beach which is easily accessible.

The nearest village is Emsworth, a historic market town approximately 2 miles away. Havant is 5 miles from Baker Barracks and is the closest large town with all the associated major facilities including a leisure centre with swimming pool and major supermarkets and a mainline station. The nearest cities are Chichester and Portsmouth (both 10 miles away). From Portsmouth, the ferry port operates to the Isle of Wight, France and Spain daily. Southampton is 30 minutes westwards.

The Cathedral City of Chichester lies on the plain between the South Downs and the sea with routes diverging north to Winchester and along the coast, both east and west. The present city of Chichester was built on the site of the capital of Cogidubnus, the King of the Regneses and an ally of the Romans.

Chichester has excellent theatres; the Festival and Minerva which provide all year round entertainment with the renowned Summer Festival and winter programme. It has many of the familiar high street stores plus many independent small shops located off the centre square forming a cross of North South East and West streets. There are several car parks around the city. A market is held every Wednesday and Saturday in the main car park.

UNIT OVERVIEW

Baker Barracks, Thorney Island is home to 12 Regt RA and 16 Regt RA.

- 12 Regt RA is the Army's only Close Air Defence Regt and is equipped with the High Velocity Missile System (HVM) which includes both Light Weight Multiple Launcher (LML) and Self Propelled Variants (SP). The Regiment is made up of 4 equipment Batteries (9 Plassey, 12 Air Assault Minden, 58 Eyres, T Bty and 170 HQ Imjin Bty). 12 Air Assault Minden Bty provides the Close Air Defence capability to 16 Air Assault Brigade.
- 16 Regt RA is the Army's only Short Range Air Defence (SHORAD) Regt and is equipped with Rapier which is a towed Surface to Air Missile System and LEAPP which is a Radar enabled system that provides enhanced airspace situational awareness to Army ground formations. The Regiment is made up of 5 equipment Batteries and a Headquarter Battery; 11 Sphinx, 14 Cole's Kop, 30 Roger's Coy, 32 Minden and 49 Bty and 20 HQ Bty. 16 Regt RA are based out of Thorney Island but have 2 Batteries in North Luffenham and a standing operational commitment to provide SHORAD in the Falkland Islands.
- 42 Air Defence Support Battery (Alem Hamza) RA is the administrative and logistic hub for all Station matters on Thorney Island. It was created under the new Army 2020 structures to support Joint Ground Based Air Defence Headquarters and its Units. It consists of approximately 200 people

UNIT FACILITIES

The facilities and amenities on the island include a nursery, primary school, stables, the Saddle Club, St Nicholas Church, barbers, youth cadets, RA Yacht Club and water sports centre, Army Learning Centre, gymnasium, Premier shop, parents and tots group, Sure Start stay & play and children's health visitor.

TRAVEL

By car: Unit Postcode for Thorney Island is PO10 8DH

Approaching on the M3

- Join M27 at Junction 4
- Continue for 20 miles on to A27
- Continue a further 8 miles and take the A259 towards Emsworth
- At round about take 3rd exit
- At 2nd round about take 2nd exit continue approx 1 mile
- At Emsworth round about take 2nd exit continuing along A259
- After ½ mile (just after The Sussex Brewery) turn right into Thorney Road
- Continue approx 1 mile to the gate post

By bus: There is currently no bus service running to and from Thorney Island. Only secondary school transport.

By train: Havant mainline station, 5 miles from Thorney Island, offers the most frequent connection to London Waterloo and Southampton Stations. Emsworth Station is closer to the Island but operates a less frequent service. From Chichester Station (Stockbridge Rd) there is a direct train to Emsworth and Havant with further connections available to Portsmouth, Southampton and London Waterloo.
