

Get started in genealogy at Federalsburg library

FEDERALSBURG — Friday Nites in Caroline tonight presents “Getting Started in Genealogy” with Michael Dixon at 7 p.m. at the Caroline County Public Library in Federalsburg.

Using a how-to approach, this introductory program gives the beginner step-by-step instructions in genealogical research. Dixon will identify essential techniques, types of family history records and useful research facilities. He also will discuss how a family’s story fits into the larger context of history.

Dixon is an adjunct professor at the University of Delaware and other area colleges, where he concentrates on social history with a focus on mass media and criminal justice. He is the historian for Town of Elkton and the Historical Society of Cecil County, and he has provided start-up leadership in the development of a 62-acre living history museum.
