Why is Adobe discontinuing development and sales of Adobe Device Central?

Adobe works closely with customers to meet their evolving demands for testing and deploying applications and websites on various devices. Based on customer feedback and the changing market landscape, Adobe has decided to discontinue development and sales of Adobe Device Central software.

When will Adobe Device Central be discontinued?

Device Central has been included with earlier Adobe Creative Suite® editions and individual products, including Adobe Photoshop® and Adobe Flash® Professional. With the release of Creative Suite 6, effective April 23, 2012, Adobe will be discontinuing Device Central. Device Central software will no longer be included in the latest versions of Creative Suite editions or individual products.

Will Adobe continue to offer technical support for Adobe Device Central?

Yes, Adobe will continue to offer support for Device Central for installation and registration issues. Additionally, the online support resources will allow customers to access existing documentation, as well as tap into community support via the product forums. Customers with maintenance agreements with Adobe can be confident they will continue to receive support for the duration of their contract.
