# College student support funds: outcome of the in-year management of student support funds for AY 2012-13

#### **Purpose**

- 1 This circular provides information on:
  - the outcome of the in-year management of student support funds for academic year (AY) 2012-13; and
  - the clawback of unspent student support funds for AY 2010-11.
- Colleges were informed that the unspent funds which are to be clawed back from AY 2010-11 will be used for the in-year management of student support funds in AY 2012-13.

#### In-year management of student support funds AY 2012-13

- The in-year management of student support funds is an on-going feature of the funding cycle, giving colleges the opportunity to request additional funds for bursary, Further Education (FE) discretionary funds as well as Further and Higher Education childcare funds.
- Full details of the outcome of the exercises undertaken for AY 2012-13 are announced in Annex A of this circular. Table 1 provides a summary of the total funds to be clawed back, funds that colleges have relinquished in-year and the distribution of allocated funds. Table 2 breaks down the amount of funds awarded to colleges as a result of this exercise. A detailed model to accompany this circular is available to download in excel format from our website:

## Clawback of unspent AY 2010-11 student support funds

- Funds that are allocated for student support purposes in any year if not used are subject to recovery by the Scottish Funding Council. On 4 October we emailed college Principals and Directors of Finance with details of the amounts to be clawed back to enable them to review the calculations.
- The method used to calculate the clawback varied slightly from previous years and is explained in more detail in Annex B of this circular. Table 1 gives a breakdown of the total student support funds to be clawed back from each college. A detailed model in excel

## Relinquished funds, recovery of unspent funds and adjusted payments

- Colleges who have requested additional funds will have the available funds paid to them in full in January 2013. We have been able to fund around 73 per cent of funds requested.
- We intend to recover the relinquished funds for both AY 2011-12 and AY 2012-13 from those colleges who have indicated that they have funds available, together with the unspent student support funds from AY 2010-11 clawback exercise.
- We intend to recover all of the funds, where possible, from college bursary funds. However, where there are insufficient bursary funds, we have checked that colleges will receive sufficient overall programme funds in January 2013 to allow us to still recover these funds in full. #### Outcome of the in-year redistribution process

Demand for student support is unpredictable and, in order to match our funding to demand as closely as possible, we carry out an in-year redistribution of student support funds in October each year. We do not allow colleges to automatically carry-forward funds, they have to relinquish unspent funds or these funds are clawed back. This allows us to provide funds for colleges that need an in-year uplift.

## Funding requests

The total amount of funds colleges are seeking is £8.2 million, an increase of eight per cent on the total allocation announced in circular <a href="SFC/15/2012">SFC/15/2012</a>. The breakdown of this figure is shown below:

We have noted that a few colleges have requested a significant amount of funds which accounts for 52 per cent of the total sum claimed. We have engaged with these colleges in order to understand the drivers for this demand.

## Relinquished and clawed back funds

The total amount of relinquished funds from this exercise is £5.3 million from 19 colleges. The table below show the breakdown of these figures.

- In addition to the relinquished funds, £0.7 million has been clawed back in respect of unspent AY 2010-11 funds from 15 colleges.
- 6 This provides a total of £6 million to be allocated.

#### SFC response to increased demand

- In recognition of continuing demand the Scottish Government provided an additional £11.4 million which enabled the Scottish Funding Council to increase the student support budget to £95.6 million (as announced in <a href="SFC/02/2012">SFC/02/2012</a> which excludes HE childcare).
- 8 The total amount of student support funds is £99.5 million; this includes the £3.9 million of HE childcare funds announced in circular SFC/15/2012.
- 9 From the funds relinquished and clawback we have £6.0 million of student support funds available for reallocation. We have allocated the funds in proportion to the requests from colleges, colleges who have requested funds will get at least 73 per cent of what they requested. The allocations are set out in Table 2.
- Two colleges provided evidence of a significant and distinctive shift in student support and we have provided a small uplift for these colleges.

## Clawback of unspent AY 2010-11 student support funds

### Identifying unspent funds

- 1 The student support funds available to a college in AY 2010-11 were:
  - its allocations announced in circular <u>SFC/14/2010</u>;
  - plus any funds awarded from the announcement of additional £5 million announced in circular <u>SFC/06/2011</u>;
  - incudes any funds received or minus any fund relinquished in the redistribution for AY 2010-11 (see <u>SFC/36/2010</u>); and
  - any funds received for economic downturn and or from European Social Funds Priority 1 programme.
- 2 Unspent funds are available in AY 2010-11 less the relevant audited spend for that year. For clawback purposes, FE discretionary and FE childcare funds are shown as separate allocations.
- A cap was applied on the use of bursary funds for study expense allowance and for AY 2010-11 this was reduced to 15 per cent of the total bursary allocation as announced in <a href="SFC/17/2011">SFC/17/2011</a>. Spend beyond this level on the study expense allowance must be met from other college resources and will not have been considered as qualifying spend.
- For this year only colleges will be allowed to carry forward funds totalling the amount of additional student support awarded in March 2011 (as announced in <u>SFC/06/2011</u>) in recognition of the lateness of the award.
