Decision

1. The official, Mr Lionel Haven, is found guilty of infringements of art. 13 (General rules of conduct), art. 15 (Loyalty) and art. 18 (Duty of disclosure and reporting) of the FIFA Code of Ethics.
2. The official, Mr Lionel Haven, is hereby banned from taking part in any kind of football-related activity at national and international level (administrative, sports or any other) for a period of five (5) years as of notification of the present decision, in accordance with art. 6 lit. h) of the FIFA Code of Ethics in conjunction with art. 22 of the FIFA Disciplinary Code.
3. The official, Mr Lionel Haven, shall pay a fine in the amount of CHF 3,000 within 30 days of notification of the present decision. Payment can be made either in Swiss francs (CHF) to account no. 0230-325519.70J, UBS AG, Bahnhofstrasse 45, 8098 Zurich, SWIFT: UBSWCHZH80A, IBAN: CH85 0023 0230 3255 1970 J or in US dollars (USD) to account no. 0230-325519.71U, UBS AG, Bahnhofstrasse 45, 8098 Zurich, SWIFT: UBSWCHZH80A, IBAN: CH95 0023 0230 3255 1971 U, with reference to case no. **150619 gaa** in accordance with art. 6 lit. c) of the FIFA Code of Ethics.
4. The official, Mr Lionel Haven shall pay costs of these proceedings in the amount of CHF 500 within 30 days of notification of the present decision, which shall be paid according to the modalities stipulated under point 3. above.
5. The official, Mr Lionel Haven, shall bear his own legal and other costs incurred in connection with the present proceedings.
6. This decision is sent to Mr Lionel Haven by DHL. A copy of the decision is sent to the CONCACAF and the Bahamas Football Association. A copy of the decision is sent to the chief of investigation, Dr Cornel Borbély.

Note relating to the terms of the decision:

Pursuant to art. 78 of the FIFA Code of Ethics, the Ethics Committee may decide not to communicate the grounds of a decision and instead communicate only the terms of the decision. The addressee of the decision has ten (10) days from receipt of the terms of the decision to request, in writing, the grounds of the decision. Failure to do so will result in the decision becoming final and binding. A request for the grounds of the decision does not affect the terms of the decision, which come into force as soon as they are communicated (art. 45 par. 1 of the FIFA Code of Ethics).

Note relating to the legal action:

Only the motivated decision can be appealed against to the FIFA Appeal Committee (Article 80 of the FIFA Code of Ethics in conjunction with Articles 119 et seq. of the FIFA Disciplinary Code).
