Blue Periwinkle	<i>Vinca major</i>	Herb	Moist, fertile soils
Bridal Creeper	<i>Myrsiphyllum asparagoides</i>	Herb	Fertile, well-drained soil
Balloon Vine	<i>Cardiospermum grandiflorum</i>	Vine	River and creek banks
Black Willow	<i>Salix nigra</i>	Tree	River and creek banks
Box Elder	<i>Acer negundo</i>	Tree	River and creek banks
Buddleja	<i>Buddleja madagascariensis</i>	Shrub	Moist areas in sun

Castor Oil Plant	<i>Ricinus communis</i>	Tree	Roadsides, Fill
Cats Claw Creeper	<i>Macfadyena unguis-cati</i>	Vine	Moist fertile soil
Fennel	<i>Foeniculum vulgura</i>	Herb	Roadsides, Wastelands
Fireweed	<i>Senecio madagascariensis</i>	Herb	Roadsides, Pastures
Giant Reed	<i>Arundo donax</i>	Reed	Riverbanks
Honey Locust	<i>Gleditsia triacanthos</i>	Tree	Roadsides, riverbanks
Honeysuckle	<i>Lonicera japonica</i>	Vine	Moist sheltered areas
Jasmine	<i>Jasminum polyanthum</i>	Vine	Moist sheltered areas
Lantana	<i>Lantana camara</i>	Shrub	Widespread
Large-leaved Privet	<i>Ligustrum lucidum</i>	Tree	Moist, nutrient rich sites
Madeira Vine	<i>Anredera cordifolia</i>	Vine	Moist, fertile soils
Micky Mouse Plant	<i>Ochna serrulata</i>	Shrub	Moist, fertile soils
Morning Glory	<i>Ipomea indica</i>	Vine	Moist, fertile soils
Moth Vine	<i>Araujia sericifolia</i>	Vine	rich soils
Paddy's Lucerne	<i>Sida rhombifolia</i>	Herb	Sunny, disturbed areas
Radiata Pine	<i>Pinus radiata</i>	Tree	Cooler climates
Small leaved Privet	<i>Ligustrum sinense</i>	Tree	Moist, nutrient rich sites
Tree of Heaven	<i>Ailanthus altissima</i>	Tree	Riverbanks, Wastelands
Turkey Rhubarb	<i>Acetosa sagittata</i>	Vine	Sunny, damp, disturbed
Wandering Jew	<i>Tradescantia albiflora</i>	Herb	Moist, fertile soils
Wild Tobacco	<i>Solanum mauritianum</i>	Tree	Roadsides, disturbed areas
