Reason and Project Scope

As part of the Route 96 Upgrade, Stop 125 Port Junction/Whiteman Street is being upgraded. The Port Junction area is a busy tram junction located near the intersection of Normanby Road and Clarendon Street, Southbank. It is a major interchange for routes 12,96 and 109 and also accommodates the waiting area for the popular Colonial Tramcar Restaurant.

Over the past 10 years, this area has seen significant growth in residential apartments and commercial activity. This has placed increased pressure on tram operations in the area. To help accommodate this growth the tram junction will be upgraded with a new improved track layout, a new level access platform at Stop 125 Port Junction and a separate level access platform for the tramcar restaurant.

Works will include

- * Separate platform for tramcar restaurant..
