## 6. TOURNAMENT FORMATS

- Only International-100 Standard championships will be played 9 Rounds by Swiss System. Turkish (Dama) events will be played 9 rounds if there are enough number (more than 18) of players.
- All other championships will be played 7 rounds by Swiss system.
- There are no duplicate places in medal qualifications. In the case of tie-break after all FMJD official criteria are same, there will be a blitz game with time control of 5min+3sec then follows super-blitz with time control of 5min+2sec.
- All rules concerning games and rights – duties of players/referees described in FMJD Annex are valid.

**7. ENTRY INFORMATION**

1. All entries will be received through National federations as well as on the website of Asian Confederation at the address <http://www.asiadraughts.org/>
2. Entries close on **20 June 2016**.
3. Entries may be submitted to the address [office@asiadraughts.org](mailto:office@asiadraughts.org) with the players' personal information. The Confederation will confirm the eligibility of entry application before the deadline.
4. Asian Cup-64 is to be considered as Asian Championship for title requirement for FMJD.
5. Teams who need visa please send the Visa Form together with all **passport copies** to [daam@mondaam.mn](mailto:daam@mondaam.mn) (Mongolian Draughts Federation) at earliest convenience before or at the Entry deadline.

**8. FLIGHT DETAILS**

**9. ACCOMMODATION**

- US\$50 per person per day including hotel room, breakfast, lunch & dinner.
- US\$40 per person per day including hotel room & breakfast without lunch & dinner
- The Organization will host each one player in age categories from the National federations.

**10. ENTRY FEE**

- Entry fee US\$50 per player per event.
- The entry fee of Standard events for adults is US\$100 per player
- A discount of 30% will be applied if played in more than 3 events

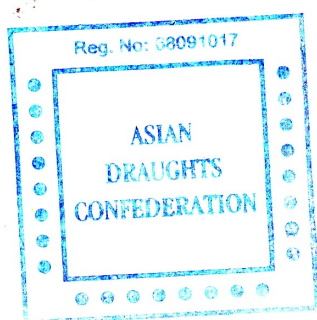
According to FMJD Annex 10 Automatic Titles will be awarded as follows in all disciplines (International-100, International-64, Turkish (Dama)):

## 12. TITLES & AWARDS

- Winners will be “Asian Champion” in respective categories, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placed players will be awarded with the official diplomas & medals
- Best 3 players in ADC-B category members will be awarded with diplomas & medals, too.
- ADC-B category members are the countries other than China, Mongolia, Kazakhstan & Uzbekistan.
