From the Georgia State Line to US 64 just east of Hayesville, NC


#### **Project Overview**

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) is proposing to improve NC 175 from the Georgia State Line to the intersection with US 64, east of Hayesville, NC. These improvements include widening the roadway and adding shoulders to meet current design standards for a 50 mile per hour roadway. The project is state-funded and is included in the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) as Project No. R-5742. These improvements provide a more desirable roadway design while minimizing impacts to properties and the natural environment.


#### **Existing Conditions**

NC 175 is a narrow, two-lane road that moves traffic in a north-south direction over approximately 4 miles, with a varying right of way width. NC 175 is a major collector roadway that provides travel to specific destinations and allows traffic flow between neighborhoods as well as countywide mobility. NC 175 begins in the south at the Georgia state line (a continuation of GA 75) and continues north to its terminus at its intersection with US 64. The Fred Woodard Bridge over Chatuge Lake (B-4733) on the northern end of NC 175 was replaced in November 2015 and includes shoulders that meet current design standards.

### Purpose of the Project

The existing travel lanes are 10 feet wide with little to no shoulders. The purpose of this project is to achieve current design standards for travel lanes and shoulder widths, while improving the horizontal alignment, vertical alignment, and the clear zone along NC 175. The proposed typical section will have 11-foot travel lanes and 8-foot shoulders, of which 5 feet will be paved. All improvements will occur on the existing alignment except the horizontal improvement between Dan Knob Drive and Sneaking Creek Drive.




Drive and Sneaking Creek Drive Curve to be straightened on NC 175 between Dan Knob
