# **PROJECT GUIDE**

CABLE KNITTIE

## Materials

1 – 50 g ball of DMC Woolly, color N49 Turquoise
US 4 (3.5 mm) knitting needles
Yarn needle

## Abbreviations

K - Knit

P - Purl

St/s - stitch/es

sts from the cable needle.

M1 – Make one. Insert the tip of the left needle from front to back under the strand linking the last st worked on the right needle and the next st to be worked on the left needle. Knit this strand through the back loop. One st increased.

C4F – Slip 2 sts onto a cable needle and hold to the front. Knit 2 sts from the left needle. Knit 2

### Instructions

Cast on 10 sts.

Row 1: \*K1, P1,\* repeat from \* to \* to end. Row 2: \*P1, K1,\* repeat from \* to \* to end. Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until tie measures about 31 inches from cast on edge.

## Cable Section

Row 1: K4, M1, K2, M1, K4. (12 sts)

Row 2: K4, P4, K4.

Row 3: K4, M1, K4, M1, K4. (14 sts)

Row 4: K5, P4, K5.

Row 5: K14.

Row 6: K5, P4, K5

Row 7: K14

Row 8 (WS): K5, P4, K5 Row 9 (RS): K5, C4F, K5.

Row 10 - 15: Repeat rows 6 and 7 three more

times.

Repeat Rows 8 – 15 for about 27 ½ inches.

## Decrease Rows

Row 1: K1, K2tog, K until 3 sts remain, K1. Rows 2 – 7: Repeat Row 1 until 4 sts remain.

Row 8: K2tog twice

Row 9: K2tog.

Draw yarn through remaining st.

Weave in the ends.
