



#### **GLX Recent Milestones**

- Notice to Proceed on Early Work Construction received October/November 2014:
  - Contract#1-Procurement of Long Lead Items
  - Contract#2-Early Utilities Phases 2/2A & 4
  - Contract#3-Miller's River & Fitchburg Line
  - Contract#4A-Procurement of Viaduct Steel
- FTA Full Funding Grant Agreement signed January 2015









#### PHASE 1 CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

- 21 Water Street Demolition: Complete
- Medford Street Rail Bridge: Anticipated to be complete by Summer 2015
- Harvard Street Rail Bridge: Anticipated to be complete Summer 2015
  - > Recent work includes moving over of commuter rail track










#### PHASE 1 CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

## Status of Design for Ball Square & College Avenue Stations

- Last station design meetings were in June 2013 at about 60% design
- Focus of design team then shifted to first 3 GLX stations to be constructed (Lechmere, Washington Street, Union Square)
- In Fall 2014 design team resumed work on Gilman Square, Lowell Street, Ball Square & College Avenue
- Ball Square Station now at 90% design
- College Avenue Station design elements vary from 30% 90% design

























# COLLEGE AVENUE COMMUNITY CONCERNS/ISSUES

- Concerns about right turn lane & drop offs
- High sidewalk along College Avenue
- Maintenance of Burget Avenue Path & station plaza
- Burget Path too narrow
- Aesthetics of the utility pipe
- Landscaping/green space
- Drop-off/pick-up capability
- Pedestrian circulation & safety
- Public art























PROPOSED ACCESSIBILITY DIAGRAM















PROPOSED ENTRANCE LEVEL FLOOR PLAN








PLATFORM LEVEL PLAN

### **Station Design Developments**

- Improved accessibility
- More opportunity for green space
- Multi-use plaza for neighborhood events
- Long term maintenance & security by Tufts on the plaza
- Improved access to Burget Avenue neighborhood
- Maintenance of Burget Avenue Path by Tufts
- Right turn lane not isolated (which will discourage drop-offs)
- Pipe blended into plaza possibly with integrated public art
