BRIAN MOYNIHAN is the chairman of the board and chief executive officer of Bank of America. Moynihan leads one of the world's largest financial institutions, and in his more than 20-year tenure at Bank of America, he has led each of the bank's lines of business, including consumer/small business banking, wealth management, and corporate/investment banking.

Bank of America serves people, companies of all sizes and institutional investors with a full range of banking, investing, asset management and other financial and risk management products and services. Bank of America is a leader in community development, philanthropy and environmental initiatives, with three major public goals: a 10-year, \$1.5 trillion community lending and investing goal; a 10-year, \$2 billion philanthropic giving goal; and a 10-year, \$50 billion goal for lending to and investing in environmental initiatives.
