AN OVERVIEW

St. Xavier's College was established in 1988 and is taken care of by the Jesuit Fathers who have been called the "Schoolmasters of Europe."

Jesuits, who render their service in 114 countries in the world, have been serving people of all faiths, as educators, scientists, explorers and social reformers since 1540. They began their educational work in Nepal in 1951 with the opening of St. Xavier's School, Godavari. Since then, hailed as the pioneers of modern education in Nepal, Jesuits have expanded their educational service to the nation by establishing St. Xavier's Schools at Jawalakhel (Lalitpur) and Deonia (Jhapa). The Moran Memorial School managed by Jesuit Fathers for the children of daily laborers in Maheshpur (Jhapa) offers almost total scholarship to all the students who study there. Similarly, St. Xavier's Sadakbari (Jhapa) is a school for marginalized tribal children. The Jesuit Fathers also run a special school for mentally challenged children in Pokhara. The other services of the Jesuit Fathers include Social Service Centers for boys and girls in Jawalakhel and Nakhipot respectively, health services through Mobile Clinics in 11 districts, and Recovery and Rehabilitation of earthquake survivors in 10 districts through Nepal Jesuit Social Institute. In all its efforts, the primary mission of the Jesuits is to build a Nepal where everyone can live with dignity and honour.

Course Duration: Two Years

Eligibility Criteria:

- Admission to Plus Two at St. Xavier's College is purely merit based.
- In order to apply, the candidate must have secured minimum 'A' in Science, Compulsory Mathematics, Optional Mathematics, English & 'B+' in all other subjects.
- Entrance Examination consisting of 100 MCQs will test your competence in Science, Mathematics, English and logic.
- The shortlisted students will have to pass an interview by a panel of three experts before being finally selected to study at SXC.

Every student has to pay:

- (A) Rs. 5000/- as guarantee deposit only in the first year which is refundable only on the completion of the course.
 - (B) Security deposit 2000/- for common events, publications, souvenirs etc.
 - (C) Rs 500/- for Education tax and I D Card.
1. Annual fee is payable in two installments as indicated i.e. during the time of admission and after four months.
 2. There is a possibility of 5% to 10% increase of fees in the subsequent years.
 3. Fees once paid will not be refunded.
