Re: Goats on the Levee(s)

- During the District's most recent levee inspection, it has been reported that goats where running ramped and where non-contained.
- The goats appeared to be running across the levee crown, slopes and its neighboring properties.
- There is a concern that the goats may cause erosion to the levee crown and the slopes.
- There is also a concern of potential diseases being spread to the cattle on the island
- The subject matter has been a big concern of the Ranchers on the island historically.
- The fact that studies have confirmed, that goats carry potentially harmful diseases to cattle was presented in a book at one of the board meeting by a local Rancher.
- The district has no knowledge and is not privy to any leases that may have been entered into with neighboring property owners for the goats to graze on.
- If there is such a lease, please notify the district for its records.
- If it is under contract with another property owner then they must stay on that property solely.
- The District does not allow for goats to be on the levee(s)
