

VIDEO ANALYSIS

Connacht GAA Centre has a fully-furnished Video Analysis Suite where we offer services to clubs and county squads. We work in conjunction with the coaches to provide feedback to players. There are a number of services which you can avail of at the centre:

1. Game recorded at external location – Footage is sent to the centre for analysis and we provide clubs with a 5-10 min. presentation of the breakdown of game depending on what the coach wants to show
2. Recording of games at centre – games are recorded at the centre from views depending on coaches' preference and the same analysis as above is performed on the footage
3. Recording and live analysis of games at the centre – At the centre we have the capability to record games and give live analysis so teams can get instant feedback on Ipad and laptop.



Fitness Testing & Screening

The Centre provides fitness testing and screening for all club and county teams. These tests will give accurate and meaningful results in areas such as % body fat, flexibility, speed, power, agility, strength and endurance. This will allow coaches to identify areas of weakness in a player's fitness and adapt their programmes accordingly.



Pitch & Meeting Room Hire

There are 6 pitches available for hire to clubs and county squads. A number of various sized meeting rooms are available for various events.

HERE comes summer! The swallows have been sighted, the cuckoo heard (just once or twice!) and the Connacht Championship is upon us. The Connacht championship evoking memories of Purcell, O'Malley, Flanagan, broken crossbars and a trip to Tuam Stadium. We were brought up on it, and we still get an extra pep in our step as we count down to it.

'Will Galway bate Mayo?' is more than a Saw Doctors single, it is the almost annual mantra that has dominated conversations in the west down the decades. It is as debatable a topic now as it ever was with glorious uncertainty and nervousness about the outcome. It encapsulates our expectations and our anxieties. Our summer depends on it.

And this year we could add another few imperponderables. "Will the Rossies rule the Roost?" "Will Leitrim cause a shock?" "Will Yeatesmen arise or go now?"

And what about another Ruislip revolution?

Yes, this year we look forward to potentially the best Connacht championship in decades. Mayo are still the ones who will take all the beating. Last year they were only a breath away from ultimate success, and their eyes are firmly fixed on the same target again. Five-in-a-row of Connacht titles would be an outstanding achievement, and they are still best placed to achieve it.

The Rossie have roared throughout the spring. The achievement of John Evans in bringing them from Div 3 to Div 1 in successive years is a huge one. The conveyor belt has been there for a while, are we about to see the finished product come off the assembly line? Roscommon have come out of the closet, they now make their way towards the mantelpiece in the full glare of their neighbours. But they are surely serious contenders.

Galway, of course, are Galway. A strong and proud county who have always played football in its present form, they have clearly been the most successful county from the province in the All-

Ireland series. They have taken a few bad body hits from Mayo in recent years and are due a retaliatory salvo. Kevin Walsh knows what it's like to win All-Irelands and he will have planned meticulously to leave Mayo in the mire. With the anticipated encounter, if it happens, due to take place in Pearse Stadium, could a terrific beauty be born?

And what if it doesn't go to script. Sligo wait in the long grass for the Ruislip victors and could easily burst the bubble of expectation that will emerge from there, while Leitrim have a tradition of spoiling someone's party when least expected to do so.

And what of our Exiles? Connacht gives true expression to the 'International dimension' of our games by inviting New York and London to take part in our championship. The Connacht counties are prepared to put their aspirations to the test by travelling to Ruislip and Gaelic Park

annually to face a test of unknown proportions. They do so because it is the right thing to do, to foster the link with two integral units of the Association overseas, and because they realise that it is about much more than a game. They are prepared to put their money where their mouth is to show it,

Much has been said about the format of our championship. While the Connacht and provincial structures may need tweaking (and they do), they should not be abandoned any time soon. The tradition of local rivalry lives, and is the very heartbeat of our summer.

And so, let the battles begin, and may the best team win!

The season thusfar saw one of the greatest games ever witnessed at Tuam Stadium in the Connacht Under-21 final thriller between Roscommon and Galway, epitomising all that is great about our games; Roscommon emerged eventual winners by the narrowest of margins, but, alas only to succumb to eventual All-Ireland champions, Tyrone, in the All-Ireland semi-final at Sligo ... the classic Titanic Tuam battle with Galway was a bridge too far for the Rossies as I think the Connacht U-21 final may have had a bearing on the Markievicz outcome! Also Roscommon CBS ended a seventeen-year gap to clinch the Connacht Post-Primary SFC for the first time since 1998. Ballyhaunis Community School also made history when capturing the Connacht Post Primary Hurling title with a two-point victory over Mercy College, Woodford, only to succumb to Cistersian College, Roscrea, in the All-Ireland semi-final ... indeed this augurs well for the future of hurling in the province as a whole.

The Centre of Excellence at Began, Claremorris, now in its third year, proved its worth in gold when showcas-

GALWAY had a sixteen point victory over New York in the the Connacht GAA Senior Football Championship preliminary fixture. Galway who were somewhat depleted prior to the game with five players ruled out through illness which resulted in a start for man of the match, Damien Comer. Galway made changes to their starting team with Tomas Healy, Eddie Hoare and Damien Comer replacing goalkeeper, Brian Donoghue, Michael Lundy and Patrick Sweeney who had fallen foul to illness, with New York also making a change with Ross Wherity being ruled out and replaced by Jason Kelly. New York made all the early running and quickly registered scores through the impressive PJ Banville before a nervous Galway had their first score through Damien Comer. As the first half developed Galway began to find their groove and had scores from Shane Walsh(3), Comer who helped himself to two points, one a belter of a '45, two from Peadar O' Griofa and a nice effort from Liam Silke. New York's response was mainly through the boot of Banville and a solitary score from New York v Galway - Connacht GAA Football Senior Championship Preliminary Round Gary

O'Driscoll. When they teams retired at half time Galway had a five point lead built up, going in 0-9 to 0-5 ahead.

Banville had the first score of the second half with a point but this only seemed to spur on this youthful Galway team with Shane Walsh finishing of a good move to the net. From here to the full time whistle, Galway helped themselves to a further 1-9, with Damien Comer particularly impressive at full forward. He also finished a flowing Galway move to net leaving his afternoon with a tally of 1-4. New York's only response came from the boot of PJ Banville.

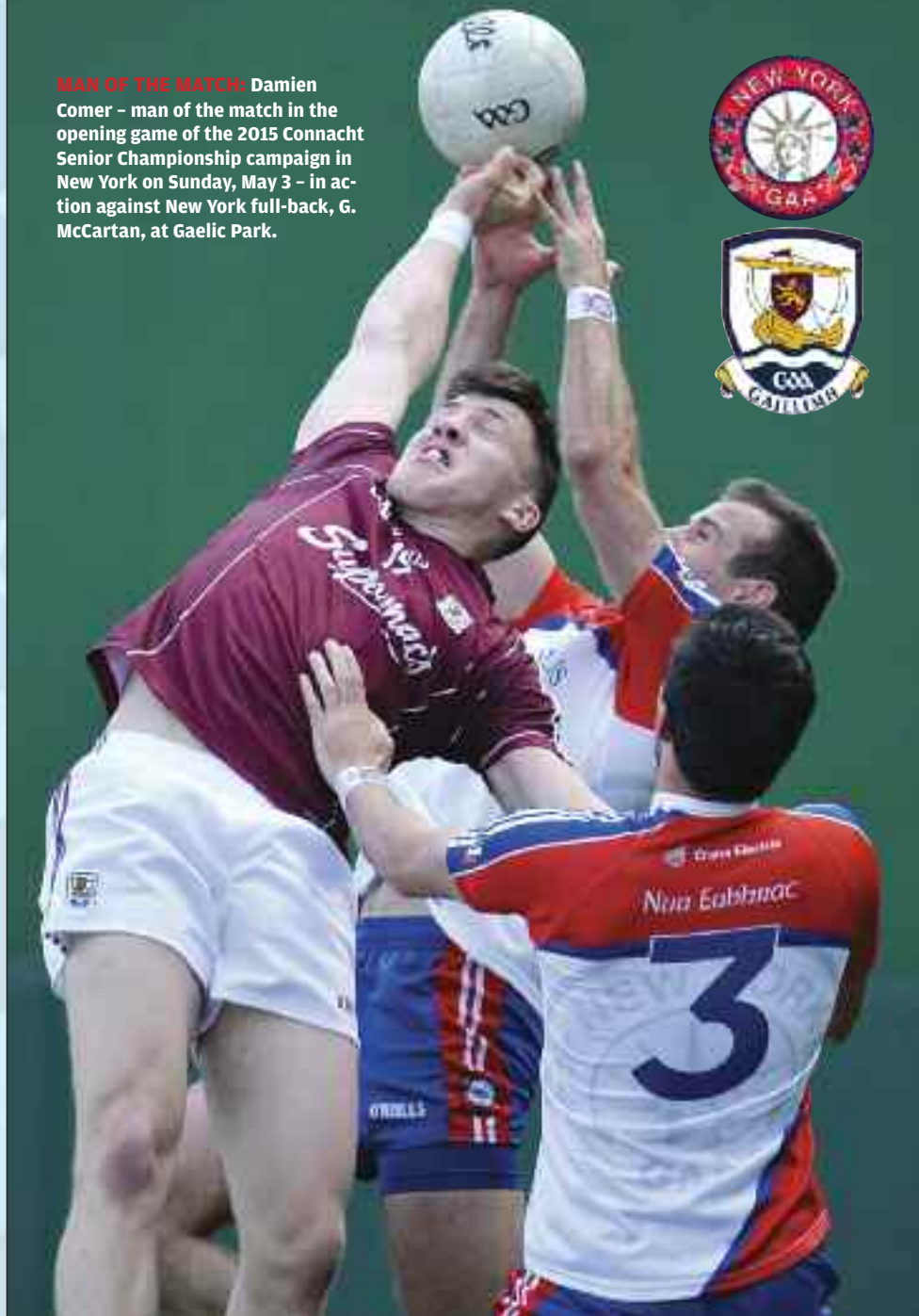
