	visit of the same year, Bishop Balaguer had both of them closed as they were on the verge of collapse. The one still standing today, known as Tas-Subricint, was rebuilt by John Baptist Azzopardi Barbara. The first stone was laid and blessed on July 10, 1759 by Rev.John Mary Azzopardi.
