Easy Knitted 1 Skein Scarf

Supplies

Yarn: 1 skein Trendsetter PandoraNeedle: Circular size 15 (24 to 36" long)

Gange

2.4 stitches per inch

Size

52 inches long by 2.5 inches wide

Directions

Cast on 125 stitches (Use a larger needle or a loose cast on).

Knit every row for about 2 ½ inches. Bind off loosely.



Diagonal Shell Erochet Eowl

Supplies

Yarn: approximately 220 yards of worsted weight yarn; our sample used Jojoland's Splatter Dash yarn.

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Gange

4 dc = 1"

3 shell rows = 1"

Size

25 inches by 7.5 inches

Stitch Abbreviations

Ch chain

Dc double crochet

YO yarn over

Edc extended double crochet foundation stitch

Directions

Foundation Row- 97 stitches.

To create a foundation row: Chain 4, YO, insert hook into 4th chain from hook, (YO and draw up a loop, Ch 1 and then complete as for regular dc: Extended dc [Edc] made). Repeat Edc for 97 stitches, working dc in ch1 of previous Edc stitch. Being careful not to twist work, join with a slip stitch to form a circle.

Hint: For each foundation Edc, pinch and hold the previous ch 1 to more easily see where to make next Edc.

2nd row- 20th row

Chain 3, 2dc in same stitch to make a shell of 3. *Single crochet into next stitch, skip 2 stitches, 3 dc in next stitch*, repeat between * until you have 20 rows of diagonal shells.

Finishing row:

Dc into every stitch to create an edge around the cowl, slip stitch into last dc and tie off.
