

Mileva Prvanović

Born in 1929 in the village of Žlne (Knjaževac, Serbia). Completed elementary and grammar school in Belgrade. Entered the Faculty of Natural Sciences and Mathematics, Department of Mathematics in 1947 and graduated in 1951. Ph.D. in Mathematics from the Faculty of Natural Sciences in Zagreb in 1955 (thesis: *Parageodesic areas and curves in a subspace of the Riemannian space*).

In the period from 1951 to 1955, Teaching Assistant at the Mathematical Institute of the Serbian Academy of Sciences and Arts in Belgrade, until the end of 1956 Assistant Professor at the Department of Mathematics of the Faculty of Philosophy (later Faculty of Natural Sciences and Mathematics) in Novi Sad. From 1957 Docent, from 1962 Associate and from 1967 Full Professor for a group of subjects in the field of geometry. Retired in 1991.

Honoured with the City of Novi Sad October Award in 1966 and the 7th July Award in 1989. Elected Corresponding Member of the Vojvodina Academy of Sciences and Arts in 1981 and became its Full Member in 1990. From 1990 Full Member of the Serbian Academy of Sciences and Arts.

Published 84 scientific papers in local and foreign journals. Author of three university and three secondary school textbooks and a number of papers. Mentored more than ten M.A. and Ph.D. theses in Novi Sad, Belgrade and Skopje. Participated in many international conferences with presentations and lectures on differential geometry. Editor-in-Chief of the *Publication de l'Institut Mateématique Journal* (Belgrade).
