At a glance

- Preferred Prime Minister More than one of two Canadians preferred Trudeau as Prime Minister (51.6%) followed by Ambrose at 15.2%, Mulcair at 10.7% and May at 5.8% (15.9% were unsure who they preferred as PM).
- Qualities of a Good Political Leader Asked a series of independent questions for each federal party leader almost seven of ten Canadians (69.4%) thought Trudeau had the qualities of a good political leader while 51.9% of Canadians thought Mulcair had the qualities of a good political leader. The third highest score on this was registered by May (35.0%) followed by Ambrose (31.1%).




National – Weekly Tracking – Preferred Prime Minister First Ranked Choice (Ending April 29th, 2016, n=1,000)

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



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

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




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Survey Methodology

The Weekly Nanos Party Power Index Tracking is produced by the Nanos Research Corporation, headquartered in Canada, which operates in Canada and the United States. The data is based on a dual frame (land + cell-lines) random telephone interviews with 1,000 Canadians using a four week rolling average of 250 respondents each week, 18 years of age and over.

The random sample of 1,000 respondents may be weighted by age and gender using the latest census information for Canada. The interviews are compiled into a four week rolling average of 1,000 interviews, where each week the oldest group of 250 interviews is dropped and a new group of 250 interviews is added.

A random telephone survey of 1,000 Canadians is accurate ± 3.1 percentage points, plus or minus, 19 times out of 20.
