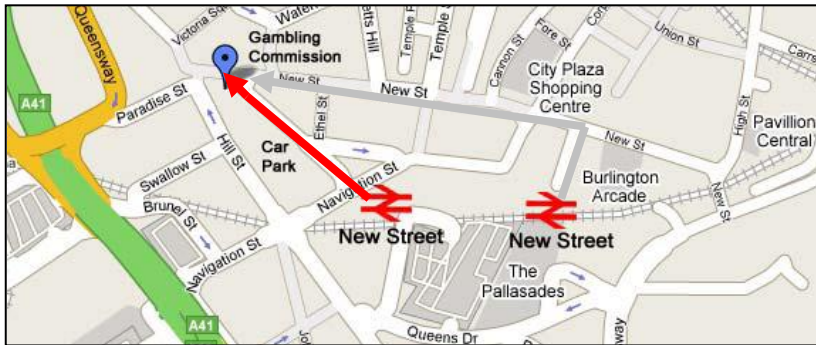

By rail

Birmingham has two major railway stations, both of which are within easy reach of Victoria Square House.

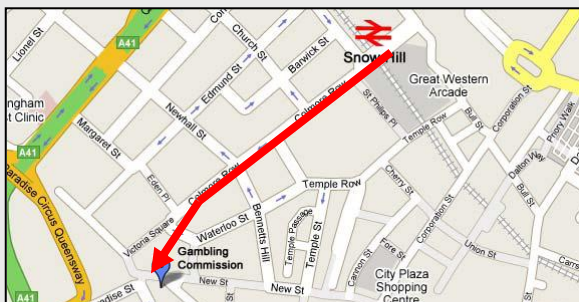
From Birmingham Grand Central New Street



Exit the station by following signs for 'Way Out Victoria Square'. Walk up Navigation Street and then take a right onto Pinfold Street.

Walk to the top of Pinfold Street and Victoria Square House is on your left.

From Birmingham Snow Hill



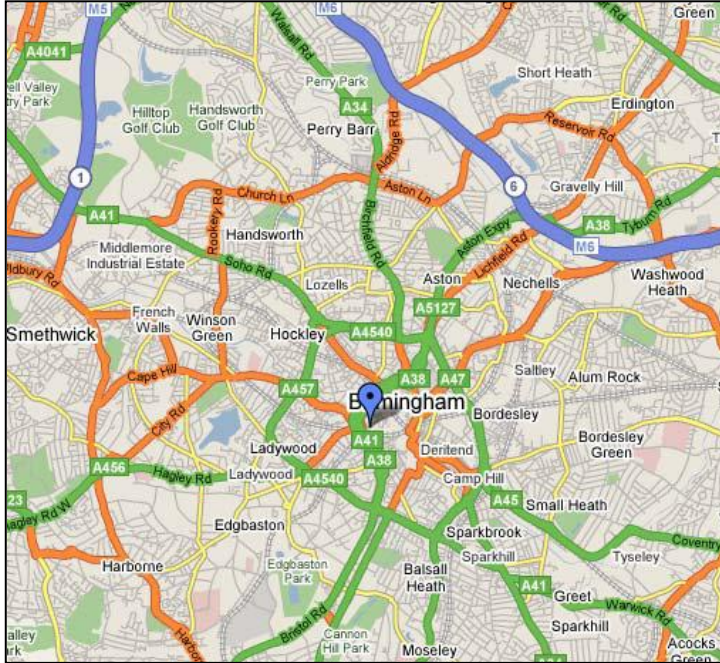
Exit from the main entrance, turn right along Colmore Row until you reach the fountain in Victoria Square.

Going down the steps, Victoria Square House is in front of you.

How to find us

By car (use B2 4AY for sat nav)

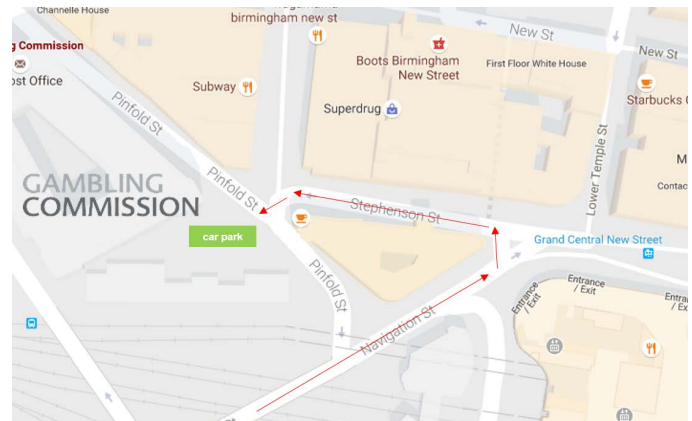
If you are visiting the Gambling Commission by car, please ask your Commission representative to arrange a parking space for you.



From the North

- The M6 links to the city from the North - take junction 4a to join the M42.
- Leave the motorway M42 (signposted Kingsbury, Coleshill), then at the roundabout take the first exit onto Kingsbury Road - A4097.
- Bear right, then join Aston Expressway - A38 motorway.
- At Paradise Circus roundabout take the first exit onto Suffolk Street Queensway.

- Turn left onto Brunel Street, left onto Navigation Street. At the traffic lights (Grand Central New Street station on your right) turn left onto Stephenson Street, Victoria Square House car park is through the gates straight ahead.



From the South

When approaching on the M42 follow the directions above.

- The M5 connects from the South - leave the M5 at junction 1, then at roundabout take the fourth exit onto the A41 (signposted Birmingham).
- At St. Chads Circus roundabout take the fourth exit onto the A38 (signposted Bromsgrove).
- At Paradise Circus roundabout take the first exit onto Suffolk Street Queensway.
- Turn left onto Brunel Street, left onto Navigation Street. At the traffic lights (Grand Central New Street station on your right) turn left onto Stephenson Street, Victoria Square House car park is through the gates straight ahead.

By air

From Birmingham International Airport

There are regular trains running from Birmingham International to Birmingham New Street station. The journey takes approximately fifteen minutes.
