#### **FOR STARTERS**

- The Georgetown University men's basketball team plays in the quarterfinals of the BIG EAST Tournament on Thursday, March 10 against No. 1 seed Villanova...
- The Hoyas are coming off a 70-53 opening round win over DePaul on Wednesday night at The World's Most Famous Arena...
- Senior guard **D'Vauntes Smith-Rivera** scored 20 points to lead three players in double figures ... It was his eighth game with at least 20 points this season and the 97th game of his career in double figures ... Senior center **Bradley Hayes**, playing for the first time since Feb. 6 after breaking his left hand, scored 10 points and had seven rebounds, and sophomore guard **L.J. Peak** added 10 points and three assists...
- The Blue & Gray, the No. 8 seed, snapped a six-game losing streak with the win and improved to 15-17 overall...
- The Hoyas have lost eight games this season by five points or less and 12 games by 10 points or fewer...

#### **AGAINST VILLANOVA**

- This will be the third meeting between Georgetown and Villanova this season ... The Wildcats won both games, the first a 55-50 decision in Washington, and then posted an 84-71 win last week in Philadelphia...
- The Hoyas have a 5-0 record against Villanova all-time in the BIG EAST Tournament ... This is the first meeting between the teams in the BIG EAST Tournament since 2008, an 82-63 GU win ... The Hoyas are 2-0 against the Wildcats in the tournament quarterfinals...

 Georgetown has an all-time record of 22-10 in the BIG EAST Tournament Quarterfinals.

#### **HOYAS STORYLINES**

- Senior guard **D'Vauntes Smith-Rivera** ranks fifth all-time in scoring at Georgetown with 1,911 points, a 14.8 per game average in 129 career games...
- His 18 points against Xavier moved him past Othella Harrington ('96) for fifth place all-time ... He needs 91 points to move past Alonzo Mourning ('92) for fourth all-time. ...
- DSR has played 15 career games at Madison Square Garden and has scored in double figures 12 times, including 11-straight games ... He has six games with at least 20 points ... In 15 career games, he is averaging 16.9 points, 4.7 rebounds and 1.9 assists ... In his last nine games, he is averaging 21.7 points, 4.2 rebounds and 2.4 assists.

#### 30 FOR 30

- Sophomore guard L.J. Peak scored a career-high 31 points in the Villanova game on March 5 ... It marked the second-straight game a Hoya scored at least 30, as sophomore forward Isaac Copeland scored a career-high 32 points and grabbed nine rebounds in the loss Marquette on March 1...
- It marked the first time two Georgetown sophomores scored 30-plus points in the same season since 1982-83, when Bill Martin (30, 12/8/82 vs. Alabama State) & Patrick Ewing (35, 12/22/82 vs. Southern).

#### OTHER NOTES

- Sophomore guard L.J. Peak scored in double figures for the 23rd time this season on Wednesday, while senior center Bradley Hayes was in double figures for the ninth time this season...
- The Hoyas hit 50.0 percent of their shots against DePaul, the sixth time this season the team has hit half of their shots (they are 4-2 in those situations).

In 11 years at Georgetown, Thompson has led the Hoyas to the 2007 NCAA Final Four, the 2007 BIG EAST Tournament Championship and to three BIG EAST Regular Season crowns (2006-07, 2007-08 and 2012-13) ... Georgetown has been to the postseason in each of his 11 seasons, including eight NCAA Tournament appearances .. The Hoyas have won at least 20 games eight times in the last 10 seasons ... He has a record of 264-132 (.667) at Georgetown and a 15-year record of 332-174 (.656), including a 68-42 record at Princeton.

## **Georgetown in the BIG EAST Tournament**

Georgetown has an all-time record of 52-29 in BIG EAST Tournament play ... When the Hoyas have been the top seed in the tournament, the team has a 15-1 record ... The Hoyas won the 2006-07 BIG EAST Tournament Championship with wins over Villanova, Notre Dame and Pittsburgh ... Georgetown has won seven BIG EAST Tournament Championships (1980, 1982, 1984, 1985, 1987, 1989 and 2007), more than any other league member.
