HISTORICAL BACKGROUND :

Nalgonda District was not a homogenous administrative unit in the past and its component parts were under the control of various dynasties at different periods of time. Nalgonda district formed part of the Kakatiya kingdom and after its down fall it became part of Bahamani kingdom and subsequently passed on to Qutub Shahi dynasty of Golkonda and on its fall was detached in the early part of 18th Century on the establishment of Hyderabad state by the Asaf Jahi dynasty. In 1947 when the country attained Independence the princely states were given a choice either to remain independent or to join the Indian union. The Nizam's dominions became part of the Indian union in 1948 as a part "B" state and in 1956 during the Reorganizations of states the Hyderabad state was trifurcated and the nine predominantly Telugu speaking districts (of which Nalgonda is one among them) known as Telangana region were transferred to Andhra Pradesh.

PRESENT STATUS:

During the decade 1951 to 1961 the district under went certain territorial changes. It lost the taluk of Jangam to Warangal district in 1953 on the eve of the formation of Khammam district and in 1958 (the uninhabited) village of Hafeezpuram was transferred from Ramannapet taluk in the district to Ibrahimpatnam taluk of Rangareddy district. Against this loss in territory the district gained in 1958 Madanapur village in kalwakurthi taluk of Mahaboobnagar district as well as Munagala paragana comprising 23 villages from Krishna district on account of its transfer to Huzurnagar taluk in 1959. The district also gained in the same year an area of five square kilometers from Palnadu taluk of Guntur district which on account of its contiguity was added to Miryalguda taluk mainly for use in connection with the construction of the Nagarjunasagar project. For administrative convenience the village of Bethavolu was transferred from suryapet taluk to Huzurnagar in 1959. The present boundaries and jurisdiction is the resultant of these changes. The district

at present is administered by five Revenue Division (1) Nalgonda (2) Bhongir (3) Miryalguda (4) Suryapet (5) Deverkonda divisions with 59 mandals in all.

BOUNDARIES & TOPOGRAPHY :

Nalgonda was formerly known as Neelagiri (Blue hill). It is bounded on the north by Medak and Warangal districts; on the south by Guntur and partly by Mahabubnagar districts; on the east by Khammam and Krishna districts; on the west partly by Mahabubnagar district and partly by Rangareddy district.

The district lies in southern part of Telangana region between $16^{\circ} - 25^{\circ}$ and $17^{\circ} - 50^{\circ}$ of northern latitude and $78^{\circ} - 40^{\circ}$ and $80^{\circ} - 50^{\circ}$ of eastern longitude. The general scope of the district is from west and north west to south east and the altitude of the district varies from 300' to 900' above sea level.

A range of hills runs through the taluks of Nalgonda and Deverkonda and enters Achampet taluk of Mahabubnagar district. Another range of low hills starts in the south west of district and extends from the vicinity of Dindi River in a north eastern direction. A third range known as the Nalla pahad after reaching Dindi and Peddavagu rivers bifurcates one span extending north and other joining the second stage. A fourth range in the north west of the district runs in the western direction as far as Sirikonda and then taking a sudden turn towards the east extends for 18 Kms and turns again to north passing between Narayanpur and Ibrahimpatnam curving again towards Vemulakonda. Besides these there are a number of isolated hills some of which are situated in on one or other of the ranges mentioned above.

RIVERS :

The district is drained and watered by the Rivers Krishna, Musi, Alair, Peddavagu, Dindi, Halia (ruralised form of Ahalaya) and Kanagal. The Krishna River which is the most important river forms the southern boundary. It first touches the district at Yelleshwaram in Deverkonda taluk and after a course of 85 Kilometers in the district in the easterly direction it enters in Krishna district. The Musi is the next important river in the district. It enters this district from north west and flows east for a distance of 64 Kilometres but after its joining with Alair river, it follows in a south easterly direction till it falls into the Krishna near Vadapalli (Wazirabad) after a course of 153 kilometres in this district. Peddavagu and Dindi are the two other important rivers that flow in Deverkonda taluk and merge in to Krishna River. Halia river rises in the west hills of Narayanpur Mandal flows in a south easterly direction for about 72 Kms when it is joined by Kanagal River near Kanagal village and continuing in the same direction falls into the Krishna River. Its total length is 132 Kms. Alair river flows in Yadagirigutta Mandal and joins Musi river. All these rivers are tapped for irrigation purposes. The Nagarjunasagar project constructed across the Krishna River, Musi project across the Musi river and Dindi project across the Dindi river and Pulichinthala Project across Krishna river between Guntur and Nalgonda border are some of the important irrigation projects.

Trivia

- **Nalgonda dist. is famous for cement factories like Vishnu, Priya, Raasi etc. and Sudhakar polymer pipes.**
- **Nalgonda, Suryapeta, Miryalguda, Devarakonda, Bhuvanagiri, Mothkur Haliya, Konda Mallepally Choutupall, Kodad, Chityala & Thirumalagiri are famous Trading and Business centers in Nalgonda dist.**
- **Nalgonda dist. has the highest number of engineering colleges apart from Ranga Reddy dist in the state of Andhra Pradesh.**
- **Pochampally sarees which are famous in India are weaved from Nalgonda dist**
- **Miryalaguda is very famous for rice mills**

PLACES OF INTEREST :

There are many pilgrims centers and places situated in this District which have cultural, social, political and historical significances such as

- 1) Fort Bhongir, which is unique of its kind in structure.
- 2) Famous Kolanpaka Jain Temple in Alair Mandal.
- 3) Yadagirigutta, which is known as second Tirupathi which attracts thousands of people daily, where Lord Laxmi Narsimha Swamy Temple is located.
- 4) Gundlapally, where the reservoir across the river Dindi is constructed and it is a spot of excursion.
- 5) Yeleshwaram of Deverakonda is known for its Archeological importance.
- 6) Janpahad Urs-E-Shareef Hazrath Janpak Shahid known for its unity in diversity.
- 7) Nandikonda is small village on bank of Krishna about 64 KMs from Miryalguda where several Buddhist structures like monasteries and pillared halls were unearthed here and preserved in a Museum of Central Archeological Department. This Museum is worth a visit.
- 8) Chaya Someshwara and Pacchala Someshwara Temple at Panagal and Pillalamarri are the noted places of visit.

NAGARJUNA SAGAR

The Nagarjuna Sagar Project at Nandikonda village of this district has been described as a “Modern Temple” and “Vision of India” by Jawahar Lal Nehru and it is highest masonry dam in the World and has created the largest lake in India. Its right and left canals are known as Nehru and Shastry Canals and these draw 36,000 cusec water and is thus a symbol of Modern India.

CEMENT FACTORIES

Nalgonda district is famous for its Cement Industries. Generally speaking, the district is rich in lime stone wealth. The big cement factories like Rassi, Vishnu, Deccan, Nagarjuna Sagar, Vasudeva are located in this District only.

HANDLOOM INDUSTRIES & HANDICRAFT

In this district 38,780 Looms are existing and this district is known for the nationwide famous Pochampally Sarees and textiles. The brass work at Chandur is also very well known.
