Synopsis:	This memo is to advise you of changes critical to MIS data collection and processing. Please read the following information carefully.

The following data element changes will be implemented beginning Summer 2016. The new data element definitions are attached.

#### SS Student Support and Success Reporting

Existing elements (SS02 to SS11) have been updated and new elements (SS12 to SS20) have been added to allow for noncredit student success service reporting. Noncredit service reporting will be optional for 2016-17 and mandatory beginning Summer 2017.

#### SP02 STUDENT-PROGRAM-AWARD

SP02 has been updated to allow for reporting of Baccalaureate degrees.

- New Credit Award Type: Y = Baccalaureate of Arts (B.A.) degree
- New Credit Award Type: Z = Baccalaureate of Science (B.S.) degree

# SD01 STUDENT-PRIMARY-DISABILITY and SD03 STUDENT-SECONDARY-DISABILITY

SD01 and SD03 have been updated to allow for new disability categories to be reported based on recent changes to Title 5

- New Disability Category: A = Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD)
- New Disability Category: U = Autism Spectrum
- Updated Definition: D = "Developmentally Delayed Learner" to "Intellectual Disability"
- Updated Definition: P = "Psychological Disability" to "Mental Health Disability"

# SG Special Populations Reporting/CAFYES

A new element has been added to the SG file to allow for Cooperating Agencies Foster Youth Education Support (CAFYES) Program reporting. SG11 STUDENT-CAFYES-STATUS will indicate a student's CAFYES participation status for the reporting term. Reporting will be optional for 2016-17 and mandatory beginning Summer 2017.

# SF21 Student Aid Award Type

SF21 has been updated to allow for reporting of new award types.

- New Award Type: GK = CalWORKs Grant
- New Award Type: GY = CAFYES Grant
- New Award Type: LY = CAFYES Loan
- New Award Type: WK = CalWORKs Loan
- New Award Type: WY = CAFYES Work Study
- Updated Definition: GD = "Supplemental grant for Cal Grant B Full Time recipients" to "Full-time Student Success Grant"
