- The closing date for applications is the 4th April 2016 or when the course is full. We will hold a reserve list on all courses.
- An invoice will be sent out to all successful applications by the end of April. This MUST be paid by the 31st May otherwise your place will be offered to a person on the reserve list.
- All cancellation after the 31st May will be charged a 15% cancellation fee.
- There will be no refunds for cancellations made after the 10th July 2016.

Previous experience and hours entered in the applicant's logbook will be a chief factor when selecting the best course for the applicant. If the applicant cannot show that they have done any sailing since the previous Sail Training Weeks, they may be offered the same course they did in 2015.

Conditions of Applications

Age 18 + must be a member of BHYC before 31st March 2016

Age 8 - 17 must be a cadet member before 31st of March 2016 and must have a responsible Adult who must also be a member of the Club before the 31st March.

Age under 10 must have a Parent or Grandparent as a club member before the 31st March who is responsible.

All Applicants must feel confident in the water.

RYA Advanced Courses. RYA Sailing with Spinnakers / Performance Sailing (RS Feva / 420) (£235)

For Youth / Adult sailors who have Seamanship and or Start Racing and wish to improve their sailing techniques both as helm and as crews, working together to get the best out of the boat. Concentrating on the advanced skills of Sailing with Spinnakers, Performance sailing and trapezing along with racing techniques and tactics.

“Start Sailing” Sailor 8 to 12 YSS Stage 1 (Oppies) (£160) 4 day course.

A Course to introduce young sailors to water borne activities. Fun and games both on and off the water working towards the RYA YSS Stage 1 certificate.

STW Course 1 Young Sailors 10+ YSS Stage 1/2 (Oppies) (£205)

For sailors who have not got RYA YSS Stage 1 but may have worked on some sections, or RYA YSS Stage 2 and wish to complete RYA YSS Stage 2, working as both helm and crew.

STW Course 2 Young Sailors 10+ YSS Stage 2 (Pico's) (£205)

For sailors who have completed RYA YSS Stage 1 and worked on some sections of RYA YSS Stage 2 and wish to complete RYA YSS Stage 2, working as both helm and crew.

STW Course 3 Young Sailors YSS Stage 3 (Pico's) (£235)

A Course suitable for those 11yrs and above who have completed RYA YSS Stage 2 and wish to improve their sailing and work towards RYA YSS Stage 3.

STW Course 4 Young Sailors YSS Stage 4 (Pico's) (£235)

A course for children with experience who have completed all RYA YSS certificates up to RYA YSS Stage 3 or have proven ability to this level and want to improve their skills up to YSS Stage 4, these skills include sailing a double hander as crew or helm and an introduction to simple racing techniques.

STW Course 5/6 Seamanship / Start Racing (RS Feva / 420) (£235)

For Youth sailors who wish to improve their sailing techniques both as helm and as crews, working together to get the best out of the boat. Learning the advanced skills of Seamanship and Start Racing.

STW Course, RYA Assistant Instructors (£50).

For those students who wish to start on the instructors ladder, by passing their skills and experience onto others. This is “on the job” training with additional separate instructor inputs as a group. Minimum standard is to have passed at least one of the National Sailing Schemes Advanced Modules. Recommendation from Principal/Chief Instructor.

Adult RYA NSS Level 1&2 Start & Basic Skills 16+ (£235) 5 day course

This course is for adults (16+) who want to learn to sail with like-minded beginners away from young eyes and their helpful comments. An introduction to sailing, covering the RYA NSS Level 1 Start Sailing and NSS Level 2 Basic Skills modules. This course offers a variety of boats to sail including Swans, Bahia and 420's

Adult Improvers RYA NSS Level 3 Better 16+ (£220) 5 day course

Adult improvers course for those who can sail and wish to improve their skills and learn new ones. The NSS Level 3 Better sailing course introduces you to elements of Racing, Day Sailing, Seamanship and Spinnakers skills, the course is your chance to improve your confidence.

RYA Powerboat Level 1+2 Adult 16+ (£220) 3 day course

In a practical environment you learn how to check and control a powerboat, take your skills up to RYA PB Level 2 standard. Spend more time on the water than a normal course to gain experience of “on the water” situations.

Cadets between 16-18yrs can make the choice between cadet or adult courses.
