#### **Odstock, Nunton and Bodenham WI**

A packed room of members was welcomed by Elizabeth Cutter, our President. Anne Waight had provided a lovely spring arrangement for the President's table, and was duly thanked.

Our theatre, walking, sewing, skittles, Scrabble, book and gardening clubs were all mentioned, especially the skittles team who won their match last month.

Local invitations were announced, and dates of county events to celebrate the centenary were given. Diane Crump has made a banner for this based on fun and friendship in the WI. Other events are published in a diary composed each month by Wendy Duke. The fifth Monday in March will be an Indian cookery demonstration.

The President held a draw for two bursaries to Denman College. These were won by Margaret Morgan and Sue Amey (who also announced the date and venue of our summer outing, which is to be Bowood House in July).

Names were taken for the performance of Raising Agents, a portrayal of 100 years of WI in Britain. This is to be performed by the Mikron Theatre Company in Salisbury in July. Our President had initiated this event, and we have invited local WIs to attend.

The highlight of the meeting was our speaker Lesley Meaker on "Art in Salisbury District Hospital". Art Care in Hospitals is a 22-year old charity with no NHS funding which provides art exhibitions throughout the hospital. There are 2,000 pieces in the hospital, a resident artist and a team of volunteers who help with exhibitions and activities on the wards, particularly children's and dementia. This encourages the hospital to provide colour and comfort to patients. Lesley had brought reminiscent packs, and members experienced how these provide conversation and memories. There were tactile objects for disabled patients as well. She provides gardens for patients and visitors alike. Our WI has an involvement in one of the gardens, and a group of members is busy working there. She maintains SDH history going back into the 1700s when the Infirmary began. There is also a staff art club offering courses in stonework, painting, sewing, pastels etc. at a subsidised rate. A vote of thanks was given by Julia Joynt.

#### **Longford C of E Primary School**

Term started (or didn't) with an extra day's holiday for the children, courtesy of the new biomass boiler which failed to do its job of heating the school. A temporary heating plant was quickly installed which, whilst not as 'Green' as the biomass boiler, allowed the School to open for a belated start to the term on Wednesday 6 January. County, the installers and the manufacturers are all working to rectify the problem and we hope to be both eco-friendly and warm soon.

But the new term really kicked off with a 'Building and Construction' fun day, which ended with the Grand Opening of the new School extension on 16 January 2015. Blessed by the Venerable Archdeacon Alan Jeans and officially opened by Lord Radnor, pupils, staff, parents and friends celebrated with a splendid cake, provided by Year 1 catering students of Wiltshire College, Salisbury, and other refreshments provided by Tesco and HC3S (the latter also supply our hot school lunches). Thanks to all those who made this event such a special day including sponsors: Rigg Construction, who supplied the commemorative plaque, and Futurform, who supplied the red ceremony ribbon cut by the Earl of Radnor. Last, but certainly not least, we owe special thanks to Sally Crook who worked so hard with Naomi Shrimpton, our Head Teacher, to organise the whole event.

The highlight of the day, from the pupils' point of view perhaps, was the release of red helium balloons (provided by Party Seasons and FOLS). There was much excitement as each child released their named balloon from the deck behind the Hall and watched them rise high in the sky carried rapidly by the cold wind until they disappeared. Following a few days of wild speculation about where they would end up, reports trickled in to confirm 10 balloons had been found - in Surrey, Winchester, West Sussex, Petersfield and Romsey. Emily's balloon won the prize for the furthest distance carried (by just 0.2 miles).

The School now has a large screen and speakers in the Hall that will be used to support collective worship times as well as aspects of PE. Laptops and classroom computers have also been upgraded to enhance teaching.

Our School Councillors: Peter, Toni-Marie, Zachary, Ash and Ethan took part in 'Small Talk' with Pat from Spire FM. The children had a great time answering questions from Pat as they gave him the lowdown on improving the school, crazy dreams, and living in Britford. The last day of term started with Celebration Worship, where Magpies (Years 1 and 2) showed off their furnished houses made of cardboard, a fitting end to the term's theme of building and consruction that started with the new Hall opening.

Term culminated with a Valentine's Disco, provided by FOLS, for which pupils changed into their party clothes and danced the afternoon away.
