1. Introduction

1.1 Purpose of the Guide

The Seoul 2015 IBSA World Games Accreditation Guide has been made by the Seoul 2015 IBSA World Games Organizing Committee(SWGOC) to ensure the accreditation of eligible personnel with the IBSA World Games Identity and Accreditation Card(IWGIAC), allowing them access to specific zones to perform their official functions.

This guide also contains detailed provision of the accreditation process including production, issuance and categories of IWGIACs, as well as its and range of use. It aims at facilitating the work for valid terms participating IBSA member countries as well as relevant organizations. In addition, this Guide provides the practical guidance for SWGOC in its preparatory work for the Seoul 2015 IBSA World Games.

1.2 Overview of Accreditation

The purpose of accreditation is to identify individuals and their roles at the Seoul 2015 World Games, while allowing them to have the necessary access to perform their roles.

Accreditation is not an external sign of a privileged status but is a necessary working tool to manage the large number of people participating in the Seoul 2015 World Games, facilitating their movements in a flexible and secure fashion.

Accreditation:

- Ensures that only the appropriately qualified and eligible people are entitled to participate in or perform official functions at the Seoul 2015 World Games.
- Limits participants' access to the areas they need to go to perform their official functions and keeps unauthorised people out of secure zones.
- Assists participants in reaching their assigned areas in a safe and orderly manner.

1.4 Accreditation Procedure

1	Establishment of Online Accreditation System from SWGOC.				
2	SWGOC distributes the Accreditation Guide to Responsible Organizations.				
3	Responsible organizations submit completed Accreditation Application Forms to SWGOC. ** Refer to the instruction of the Online Accreditation System on the Accreditation website.				
4	IWGIACs are produced by SWGOC for responsible organizations.				
5	SWGOC will hold Delegation Registration Meetings (DRM) with Member countries to verify the accuracy of information submitted in the Accreditation Application Forms.				
6	At the Delegation Registration Meeting(DRM), the accuracy of relevant application materials and eligibility of the applicants to participate in the Games are finally confirmed by SWGOC in cooperation with IBSA Membership countries.				
7	After the completion of the DRM, Participants bring their passports to receive the IWGIACs at the Accreditation Desk.				
8	IWGIACs will be distributed to participants upon confirmation of their passport.				







2. IBSA World Games Identity and Accreditation Card



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2. IBSA World Games Identity and Accreditation Card

2.1 Function of the IWGIAC

The IBSA World Games Identity and Accreditation Card(IWGIAC) function is:

• The IWGIAC provides a basis for the access permission of the Games venues and enables SWGOC to confirm the identity of the participants.

2.2 Valid Period of the IWGIAC

The IWGIACs for the Seoul 2015 World Games are valid from 00:00(GMT+9) May 8th to 23:59(GMT+9) May 18th, 2015.

2.3 Specification of the IWGIAC

2.3.1 Form of the IWGIAC

- The size of the IWGIAC is $10 \text{cm} \times 15 \text{cm}$.
- It contains the holder's rights granted by the accreditation category and identification information on both sides of the card.

2.3.2 Language on the IWGIAC

The languages of the information on the card are:

- English
- Korean

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3. Accreditation Application

3.1 Online Accreditation Application

The Accreditation Application Package including Accreditation Guide and Application forms will be distributed to responsible organizations from February 2015. Accreditation Guide and Application Forms are available to download on the online accreditation system.

SWGOC will distribute a user ID and password which will allow responsible organizations to log into the Online Accreditation System to download the Accreditation Guide and Application Forms.

Responsible organizations are reminded to reset their passwords when they first log on to the accreditation system for the first time.

Users may change their passwords whenever they want throughout the application process.

Accreditation application will be accepted through the online system and excel file. SWGOC will arrange an alternative solution for the responsible organizations that cannot use the online accreditation system.

3.2 Submission of the Accreditation Application

The Accreditation application will be accepted by online application and excel file from 00:00(GMT+9), February 23rd, 2015 until 23:59(GMT+9), March 27th, 2015. Responsible organizations can not be accessed to modify the application information on the Online Accreditation System after the deadline.

The deadline set by SWGOC allows responsible organizations an adequate amount of time to complete the accreditation process for the Games.

3.3 Corrections of Information in the Accreditation Application Form

In the event that any information contained in an Application Form which has already been submitted needs to be corrected, the responsible organizations need to notify to SWGOC and receive temporary submission access.

Before the application submission deadline, accreditation applications are able to corrected, modified or deleted by the responsible organization.







3.4 Verification of Accreditation Information

SWGOC will send the Accreditation Information List to the responsible organizations after the accreditation deadline. The Accreditation Information List contains the applicants' personal information, category, accreditation numbers, access entitlements of all of accreditation applicants and other accreditation information

After the completion of the information verification process between SWGOC and relevant responsible organizations, SWGOC will issue the IWGIACs.

The applicants should submit recent color photographs while completing in the application forms. If the photograph is not attached in the application form, the applicant will not be eligible to receive accreditation.

3.5 Completion of the Accreditation Application Form

Responsible organizations have to complete an accreditation application through the Online Accreditation System by March 27th, 2015. All information provided on the application form should be accurate and match the participants' passport.

Applicants must scan and upload a suitable photo when they submit the Accreditation Application Forms.

Except any special case, information of the applicants should be typed in capital Latin letters(A-Z); Arabic numerals should be used for numbers(0-9).

The applicants must choose the Accreditation Application Form suitable for their roles at the Games by selecting the correct accreditation category on







the form. The full list of accreditation categories is located in this guide under the 'Appendix Accreditation Chart'. SWGOC will then check the relevant information of the application forms.

Accompanying Guests should fill in the name of their inviter on the accreditation application forms.

X The instructions on using the Online Accreditation System will be noticed on the website of the Online Accreditation System.

The following is a list of requirements for completing the Accreditation Application Form.

① Responsible Organization

Responsible organization's names are pre-filled in the appropriate field, responsible organizations need to reconfirm the entered contents.

Application forms submitted by the responsible organizations recognized by the IBSA are only accepted. Any application requested by individual and organization applicants will be rejected.

② Accreditation Category

Select the correct accreditation category for the participant.

3 English Family Name (Using capital letters)

The family name entered must be identical with that shown on the passport.

4 Given Name (Using capital letters)

The given name entered must be identical with that shown on the passport.



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5 Date of Birth

Format: Day/ Month/ Year

e.g.) October 20th, 1982 should be entered 20/10/1982.

6 Gender

Check only one of the Genders

e.g.) ■ M □ F

7 Nationality

Country/region by which ID document is issued should be entered.

e.g.) The Republic of Korea

8 Passport Information

- · Passport number: The number entered should be identical with the one shown on the applicants' passport.
- Expiry date: The date entered should be identical with the one shown on the applicants' passport.
- · Format : Day/ Month/ Year
 - e.g.) May 18th, 2015 should be entered 18/05/2015
- X An expiry date must be no earlier than May 18th, 2015

(9) Name and accreditation number of the inviter

Those who are participants of the Games as accompanying guests should enter the inviter's name and accreditation number in the accreditation system.

10 Wheelchair User (optional)

Check the appropriate box, if the applicant uses wheelchair.







1 Sports/Discipline

It is only for Athletes, Team officials and Technical officials.

12 Copy of Identification

Applicants are requested to submit a copy of valid passport or a travel certification to SWGOC.

(13) Photograph

Applicants are requested to submit their photo files to SWGOC.

▶ Photo Requirements

- The image format must be ".jpg" or ".png" and size of image should be between 50kb and 100kb.
- If the photos are submitted in separate with the application forms, the file naming must be done in the format of full name passport number.
 - e.g.) BRIANKO M1111111
- Facing forward, looking straight at the camera with eyes open and nothing covering the face.
- Looking natural with no facial expressions, smiling, grinning or frowning.
- Nothing covering the eyes, hair or glasses' frames.
- No sunglasses or tinted glasses.
- No hat or anything covering the head unless for medical or religious reasons.
- The photos must be taken within the last six-months and in color.
- The photographs should be in sharp focus and clear and un-retouched with no smears or creases.
- The background of the photo should be either white or plain light blue. The boundary between a person and the background should be identifiable.

4. Issuance of Accreditation Card

4.1 Production and Distribution of IWGIAC

Based on the confirmed Accreditation Status List by responsible organizations, SWGOC will produce IWGIACs. SWGOC will distribute the IWGIACs when participants arrive in the accreditation desk. Participants must bring their own passport to receive the IWGIACs. Once distributed, the IWGIACs become effective, allowing the holders access to venues and zones indicated on the Cards.

Procedure for distribution of IWGIAC

Phase	Description
1	Visit the SWGOC Accreditation Desk ** Please refer to the Chapter 5.1 Operation of Accreditation Desk
2	Check the IWGIACs and Participants' passport **Show the passport to compare and confirm information of IWGIAC
3	Distribute IWGIAC and approve to access Games Venues

However, the IWGIACs cannot be distributed under the following circumstances.

- The applicant haven't submitted the information before his/her arrival in the Republic of Korea
- Contained information in the IWGIAC holder's identification document is inconsistent with that in the Accreditation System.







4.2 Reissuance of IWGIAC

In the event that distributed IWGIAC is lost or damaged, the card holder should report it to their relevant responsible organization immediately, who will then notify SWGOC in a written report about the case. Lost or damaged IWGIACs will be cancelled on the accreditation system, and will not be able to be used.

The applicants who attach a copy of their passports and have submitted the report forms confirmed by responsible organization can then obtain reissued IWGIACs

4.3 Extra Officials

Delegations whose official-to-athlete ratio exceed 60% may apply for "As" accreditation category for their extra officials.

Without prior agreement between an IBSA Member Countries and SWGOC, team officials beyond the number limit specified in the Seoul 2015 World Games Accreditation Guide will not be accredited as Extra Officials.

Only the following personnel will be considered for accreditation as "Extra Officials":

- Coaches and Assistant Coaches
- Administrative Personnel
- Medical Personnel
- Guide for Blind People








4.4 Quota for IBSA Membership Country Team Officials

IBSA Member Country Team Officials include the delegation members in the area of administrative, technical and medical official for the participating sports of IBSA Member Country and who reside in the Games official hotel

Regarding team official quota, the official-to-athlete ratio will not be allowed to exceed 60%. But the guide persons of B1 athletes will not be counted in the quota. Each B1 athletes are allowed bring one personnel assistant for them.

Although any delegation exceed 60% of official-to-athlete ratio, the quota is not be applied to the number of team official if they have less than ten(10) athletes.









4.5 Athlete Competition Partners

Introduction

Athlete Competition Partners are persons without impairment whose participation is essential to guide athletes in designated sport classes that require such assistance during the competition. Athlete Competition Partners fall under the "Ab" accreditation category.

The following applies for the eligible sports and it could be modified by TD:

Athletics Guide Runners: Each athlete will be assigned with one running guide, and the latter will be allowed entry into the corresponding sports classification along with the athlete for whom he/she needs to guide.

4.6 Media Accreditation Application

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For the accreditation for Media organizations from IBSA and IBSA Membership Countries should distribute the Media Accreditation Application Forms to the media organizations within their territories. Media organizations should identify each individual to be accredited and return the completed Media Accreditation Application Forms to the responsible organization.

SWGOC is directly responsible for the accreditation of media organizations from non-IBSA membership countries and international media organizations.

Each membership country is responsible for the distribution of the Application Forms of media organizations to SWGOC before the deadline.
