NOTIFICATION PURSUANT TO ARK. CODE ANN. § 23-63-613 OF PUBLICATION OF NAIC ACCOUNTING PRACTICES AND PROCEDURES MANUAL ("APPM") AS OF MARCH, 2011

The Arkansas Insurance Department is sending you this Bulletin as notification of the Commissioner's intent to adopt the amendments, revisions, or modifications to the <u>ACCOUNTING PRACTICES AND PROCEDURES MANUAL AS OF MARCH</u>, 2010, published by the National Association of Insurance Commissioners ("NAIC").

This notice is required by Ark. Code Ann. § 23-63-613 to allow the Commissioner to specify that domestic insurers and other domestic reporting entities shall use the most recent 2011 edition of APPM, no sooner than eight (8) months after distribution of the required statutory notice.

Therefore, please be advised that the <u>effective date</u> for the prescribed use of the <u>ACCOUNTING PRACTICES AND PROCEDURES MANUAL AS OF MARCH</u>, 2011 for Arkansas domestic reporting entities shall be for the Annual Statement as of December 31, 2011, to be filed with this Department on or before **March 1, 2012**.
