Know 2 Ways Out!

IMPORTANCE OF PLANNING

Don't take the chance that everyone in your house will know how to get out in a fire. The only way to ensure everyone knows how to get out is to practice. This is especially important for families with young children.

Statistics have shown that people always go to the most used or last used door. What if that door is the origin of fire? Will you or other members of your household know a 2nd way out?

Follow the instructions; practice the escape plan with all members of your house and then post this somewhere in your house to remind you to practice & review every year!

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Draw a diagram of your home showing 2 ways out of each room.
2. Walk through your home to ensure all escapes are accessible and operational for everyone in the house.
3. Pick an outside meeting place
4. Go through the plan with everyone in your household.
5. Practice your plan at least twice a year
