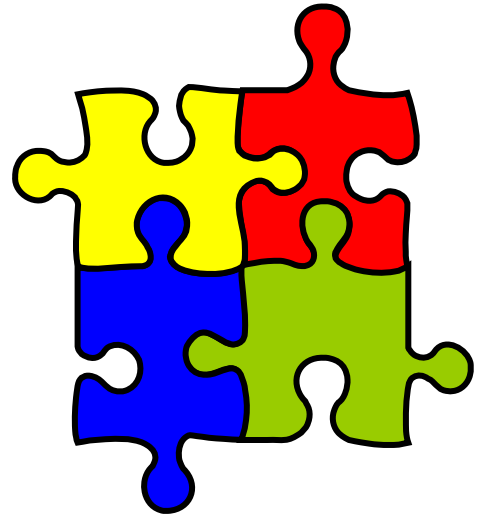

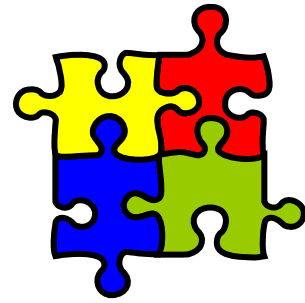

### Information and Guidelines for Courthouse Visitation

*Welcome to the Middlesex Judicial District Courthouse, 1 Court Street, Middletown, CT.*

The following information pertains to your attendance at the Judicial Branch celebration commemorating the 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the ADA:

1. Regular parking is available in the public lot on Court Street - adjacent to the courthouse. Parking is free for up to two hours.
2. Accessible parking, with shared access, is available in the public lot on Court Street - adjacent to the courthouse. Parking is free for up to two hours.
3. Overflow accessible parking, with shared access, will be available at the courthouse lot. Please let the Judicial Marshal on duty at the entrance booth know that you will be attending the event and you will be directed to available parking.
4. You will enter the court through the front entrance and be required to go through a metal detector. We apologize for any inconvenience and recommend you "travel light" in terms of what you bring with you. Food and beverages may not be brought in, however, a light snack will be served.
5. For this special event, cameras will be allowed in the facility. Cell phones are also allowed.
