ABOUT THE VETERANS PROGRAM

The primary objective of the Veterans Program is to develop and support programs that increase opportunities for veterans to obtain employment and job training in California. Eligible veterans are entitled to receive priority services in job referrals and referrals to training by EDD staff as well as other employmentrelated services. Veterans with disabilities receive the highest priority in all employment services.

SOME BENEFITS MAY APPLY TO ELIGIBLE SPOUSES OF DISABLED VETERANS:

- Spouses of 100 percent disabled veterans are eligible for veteran's preference points when applying for employment within agencies where veteran's preference applies.
- Spouses of 100 percent disabled veterans are eligible for California Department of Veterans Affairs' tuition fee waiver program if they are the unmarried surviving spouse of a veteran who died as a result of their service connected disability.

SERVICES FOR VETERANS

Are you a veteran looking for a job? The Employment Development Department (EDD) can help you in your search. The EDD has specially trained veterans staff who offer the following services:

PRIORITY JOB REFERRALS

For veterans only, the EDD places a 24-hour hold on job orders entered in the New CalJOBSSM – the EDD's online job and résumé labor exchange system. Veterans always receive top priority in job referrals. That means you will learn about available jobs before the rest of the job-seeking public.

DEDICATED STAFF

Our skilled veterans program staff are located throughout California. They are specialists trained in veteran employment issues and provide one-on-one assistance with applications, job interviews, and vocational guidance. With their assistance, you can learn about veteran workshops, training, and other services that may be available. They are ready to give you the priority service you deserve.

NO FEE SERVICES

In addition to job search assistance and job listings, you can take advantage of a variety of other services, including:

- Access to phones, Internet, printers, fax machines, and copy machines.
- Résumé preparation, interviewing techniques, and job search workshops.
- Referrals to other programs, including on-the-job training.
- Information on the labor market, wages, and trends.
- Vocational guidance and career counseling.
- Referrals to other services within the community.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS

The EDD participates in a variety of programs of special interest to veterans, including:

- Unemployment Compensation for Former Service Persons Provides recently separated veterans with unemployment benefits while they search for work.
- Federal Contractors Job Listing Program Provides a large source of jobs for which veterans are given priority.
